

INTERNATIONAL REDS

United States

Unshackled Wines by the Prisoner Wine Company: Cabernet Sauvignon and Red Blend Both \$24.99

The PWC's Cab delivers classic blackberry fruit with solid tannins and aging in French and American Oak. The Red Blend brings Zinfandel, Malbec, Petite Sirah, Syrah, and Grenache together for a rich, spicy, full-bodied experience.

Murphy-Goode, "Liar's Dice" Zinfandel, Sonoma County, 2014 - \$20.99

The soft tannins invite ripe, yet fresh flavors of black raspberry, black cherry, and blackberry jam.

Flowers, Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir, 2017 - \$44.99.

Floral expressions of lilac and fresh roses. Fruit flavors of Santa Rosa plum and cranberry. Notes of cedar, clove and baking spice linger for a long, savory finish

Mount Veeder Winery, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, 2016 - \$35.99

Rich, full-bodied with generous structure, yet a very supple mouthfeel with berry, peppercorn, and olive that fill the palate and lead to a long, lingering finish of dark fruit and notes of crème brûlée.

Spoken Barrel, Cabernet Sauvignon, Columbia Valley, Washington State, 2015 - \$17.99

Lush, concentrated flavors of blackberry and cherry with hints of cassis lead to a warm, toasty sweet vanilla finish.

Spoken Barrel, Meritage, Columbia Valley, Washington, 2015 - \$16.99

Dense and rich mouthfeel is accented by flavors of bright red fruits, toasty oak, smoke, chocolate, and citrus rind.

Dry Creek Vineyard, Zinfandel, Heritage Vines, Sonoma County, 2016 - \$20.99

Enticing aromatics of black cherry, boysenberry and plum with a hint of toast and white pepper. On the palate, brambly flavors of black raspberry and dark chocolate come forward. Certified California Sustainable Vineyard and Winery!

Dry Creek Vineyard, Cabernet Sauvignon, Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County, 2016 - \$24.99

Displays lively aromatics of black cherry, black currant and dried blueberry. Full-bodied and rich with elegant flavors of black currant and dried cranberry with notes of cocoa powder, espresso, nutmeg and cedar.

Daou Vineyards, 'Pessimist' Red Blend, Paso Robles, 2017 - \$22.99

A powerful and intensely aromatic red blend of Syrah, Petite Sirah, Zinfandel and Tannat; massive in weight yet elegantly structured, a powerhouse that reveals itself in stages.

Daou, Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso Robles, 2017 - \$50.99

Full-bodied and a very silky texture, this wine glides into a long, generous finish resonating with ripe fruit and exotic spice allowing amazing aging capabilities.

Mer Soleil, Pinot Noir, Santa Lucia Highlands, California, 2017 - \$25.99

Flavors of cherry cobbler mingle with cola notes and hints of anise. Tannins are structured yet extremely fine, providing a lush, lingering mouthfeel.

Benton Lane Winery, Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, Oregon, 2015 - \$26.99

The Eyrie Vineyards, Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, Oregon, 2016 - \$36.99

Organic, hand-harvested, no herbicides or pesticides allowed; fantastic acidity and strawberry fruit with notes of earth and spice.

Walt, Blue Jay, Pinot Noir, Anderson Valley, California, 2016 - \$48.99

Good acidity, floral, spicy, and full of rich fruit.

Walt, Pinot Noir, La Brisa, Sonoma Coast, California, 2017 - \$41.99

Fresh and fun, full-bodied and savory Pinot with lots of dark fruit, mocha, and iron.

Bergström, Le Pré du Col Vineyard, Ribbon Ridge, Willamette Valley, Oregon 2014 - \$59.99

Meaning "Meadow on the Mountain", look for cherry and strawberry fruit with intriguing spices and aromas of cinnamon.

French Reds

Chateau Pegau, "Maclura", Cotes du Rhone, 2014 - \$20.99

Intense aromas of cassis, blackberry, and spice, with soft, ripe, tannins on the palate and a lingering finish - a versatile, food-friendly wine.

George Vigour, Gouleyant, Malbec, Cahors 2014

90+ Cellars, Bourgogne, Lot 160, France, 2018 - \$24.99

Fragrant with red berry and floral aromas followed by a delicate but long finish, the palate is laced with fresh red cherries and plums and notes of violets.

Spanish Reds

El Tanino, "1752", Garnacha Tintorera Alta Xpression, Almansa, Spain, 2015 - \$18.99

Aromas of mature fruits and sweet spices; tasty, complex and concentrated on the palate, made from old vines with 12 months in French and American oak-barrels.

Bardos, Romantica, Tempranillo, Crianza, Ribera del Duero, 2016 - \$18.99

aroma of ripe fruits, dark fruits jams, tobacco and leather. Full-bodied wine with strong

structure and noticeable freshness. Smooth and elegant, complemented with gentle tannins and pleasant finish.

La Vinyeta, Red Blend, Emporda, Spain, 2016 - \$17.99

Cherry-colored with violet tones. High aromatic intensity, combining sensations of ripe fruit with lactic notes. Luscious mouthfeel with well-integrated tannins and medium persistence with good final acidity. Local varieties 65% Carignan and 35% Red Grenache.

Jorge Ordonez, Breca, Garnacha, Calatayud, Spain, 2015 - \$16.99

Traditional dry farmed viticulture. Organic Gobelet trained vines. Cultivated completely by hand, with minimal human intervention. The majority of the vineyards receive no treatments whatsoever.

La Vinyeta, Red Blend, Emporda, Spain, 2016 - \$17.99

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Matsu, "El Picardo", Tempranillo, Toro, Spain, 2016 - \$16.99

Matsu, "El Recio", Tempranillo, Toro, Spain, 2016 - \$28.99

Aromas of ripe black fruit, overlaid with spices such as black pepper. There is an obvious minerality to the wine, proceeding from vineyards' diverse range of soil types. An authentic, natural, and traditional wine produced from the original Garnacha.

Matsu, "El Viejo", Tempranillo, Toro, Spain, 2016 - \$59.99

Italian Reds

Copertino, Riserva, Red Blend, Puglia, Italy, 2009 - \$16.99

Made only in the best vintages and released at the winemaker's discretion after several years of bottle aging; intense, full, rich and ethereal aromas of blackberry, plum.

Republic of Georgia

Vartsikhe Marani Aladasturi, Imereti, 2018 - \$26.99

Organically farmed from 10–25-year-old vines this dry, light red from the Republic of Georgia allures with floral aromas and fresh, crisp, tart fruit on the palate. Pair with Havarti cheese, egg-based dishes, braised greens, salmon, turkey, chicken, lamb, and BBQ.

Tchotiashvili Tavkveri, Khaketi, 2017 - \$26.99

This medium- to full-bodied dry red from the Republic of Georgia has cherry, herbal, and earthy flavors that pair excellently with paella, grilled octopus, goulash, prosciutto, and hamburgers.
