# Joseph Phelps, Chardonnay, Freestone Vineyards, Sonoma Coast, 2014 - \$38.99

Bright and fresh with firm acidity and balanced minerality. Overflowing with Gravenstein apple, vanilla bean and Kaffir lime notes followed by a long lemon creme finish.

## Patz & Hall, Chardonnay, Sonoma Coast, 2015 - \$26.99

Flavors of pineapple, guava, honeydew and lime zest, as well as notes of toasted almond macaroon, cinnamon and sugar cookies. Plush and flowing to a long, layered finish.

# Flowers, Sonoma Coast Chardonnay, 2017 - \$39.99

Vibrant aromas of honeysuckle and citrus blossom are balanced with rich flavors of Meyer lemon, pear, lemon custard and wet stone. Subtle oak notes of sugar cookie and vanilla round out a rich mouthfeel with a long, full finish.

# Galerie, "Naissance", Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley, 2017 - \$29.99

Shows tropical aromas of pineapple, orange peel, grapefruit and orange blossom that lead into full flavors of apricot and orange zest, with hints of dry grass.

# Peirano Estate Vineyards, Chardonnay, Heritage Collection, Lodi, 2016 - \$14.99

Complex flavors of sweet, rich, red and yellow apples, bosch pears, fresh picked peaches and juicy sweet honeydew melons; soft hints of butter and vanilla round out the lingering finish.

# Dry Creek Vineyard, Chenin Blanc, California, 2017 - \$11.99

Orange-marmalade aromas set the stage for a rather full-bodied, dry and flavorful wine; floral and fruity elements are counter-balanced by a tangy texture and subtle mineral accents. 91 pts. Best Buy, Wine Enthusiast

On the palate is a beautiful minerality and acidity that leaves your mouth watering for more. With lean, mineral-driven flavors and bright acidity.

# Gerard Bertrand, Cote des Roses Chardonnay, IGP Pays d'Oc, France, 2018 - \$17.99

Notes of citrus fruit zest mingled with white flowers on the nose; a fresh, lively attack on the palate, typical of the Chardonnay grown on the Languedoc's "cool" terroirs.

### **AMBER WINES**

### Nine Oaks Khikhvi, Khaketi, 2016 - \$26.99

This medium-bodied amber wine from the Republic of Georgia delivers soft acidity and flavors of dried apricot, honey, and spearmint. Pair with mild cheeses, salads, and white meats. Organically farmed with spontaneous native yeast fermentation, four weeks maceration, and aged in steel. Low sulfur dosage, and only 2,400 bottles made!

# Tchotiashvili Rkatsiteli, Khaketi, 2016 - \$26.99

Kakha Tchotiashvili, a trained oenologist from the Republic of Georgia, farms 41 different varieties organically. This amber wine offers up fresh citrus fruit, herbaceous flavors, and a crisp, tannic backbone. Pair with lentil soup, baba ghanoush, root vegetable stews, and spiced meats.
