- Provide exact chemical compositions with CAS numbers where possible.

3. Correct Application Codes

 Apply OEM-specific codes in IMDS and standardized IPC-1752A codes in CDX.

4. Compliance Checks

- Cross-check against GADSL, REACh SVHC, RoHS, and ELV restricted substances lists.
- Validate thresholds (e.g., 0.1% SVHC reporting).

5. Data Consistency Across Platforms

Align IMDS and CDX entries to avoid conflicting declarations to OEMs.

6. Version Control & Documentation

 Keep a clear record of submitted versions, updates, and justifications for any changes.
