The **End-of-Life Vehicles (ELV) Directive (2000/53/EC)** sets strict requirements for automotive manufacturers and suppliers to reduce hazardous substances, improve recyclability, and ensure environmentally responsible vehicle disposal.

As the automotive industry transitions toward circular economy principles, OEMs and their supply chains must prove compliance with material restrictions and recyclability targets—placing significant responsibility on suppliers of parts, components, and materials.

### **ELV Directive: Key Compliance Requirements**

#### 1. Substance Restrictions (Annex II)

 Prohibition of heavy metals such as lead, mercury, cadmium, and hexavalent chromium, flame retardants and plasticizers except under specific exemptions.

#### 2. IMDS Declarations

 All automotive parts and materials must be entered into the International Material Data System (IMDS) to demonstrate compliance.

#### 3. Recyclability Targets

 Vehicles must be at least 85% reusable/recyclable and 95% recoverable by average weight per vehicle.

### 4. Supplier Documentation

 Suppliers must provide accurate Material Declarations and Certificates of Compliance to OEMs.

#### 5. Continuous Updates

 The ELV Directive undergoes regular updates to substance restrictions and exemptions, requiring ongoing compliance monitoring.
