

REACH SVHC & SCIP Reporting Guide

The REACH Regulation (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation, and Restriction of Chemicals) is the EU's most significant chemical regulation, requiring businesses to declare Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs) present in products above 0.1% weight by weight. Additionally, the SCIP Database (Substances of Concern in Products) extends this obligation, requiring companies to notify the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) about SVHC-containing articles placed on the EU market.

Failure to comply can result in **blocked market access, financial penalties, and reputational damage**.

What Needs to Be Reported

- **SVHC Thresholds**: If an article contains >0.1% SVHC by weight, it must be declared.
- SCIP Notifications: Each affected article must be registered in ECHA's SCIP database.
- **Updates**: Whenever ECHA updates the SVHC Candidate List (twice a year), companies must review and resubmit relevant declarations.

Key Steps in REACH SVHC & SCIP Compliance

1. Data Collection

- Gather material data from suppliers across your supply chain.
- Validate supplier declarations against the latest SVHC list.

2. Threshold Assessment

- Identify articles containing SVHCs above 0.1%.
- o Conduct "article-as-such" assessments per EU guidelines.



3. SCIP Notification Preparation

 Compile mandatory data: article identifiers, concentration ranges, and safeuse information.

4. Database Submission

Submit notifications to the SCIP portal and track confirmation.

5. Ongoing Monitoring

- o Track regulatory updates (SVHC additions occur every June & December).
- Update records and resubmit as needed.
