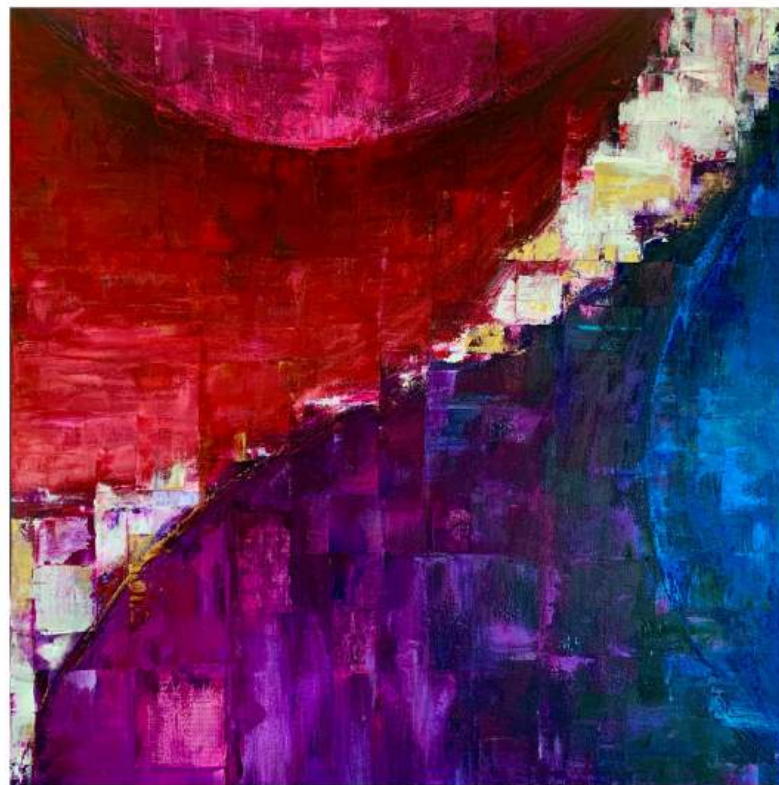

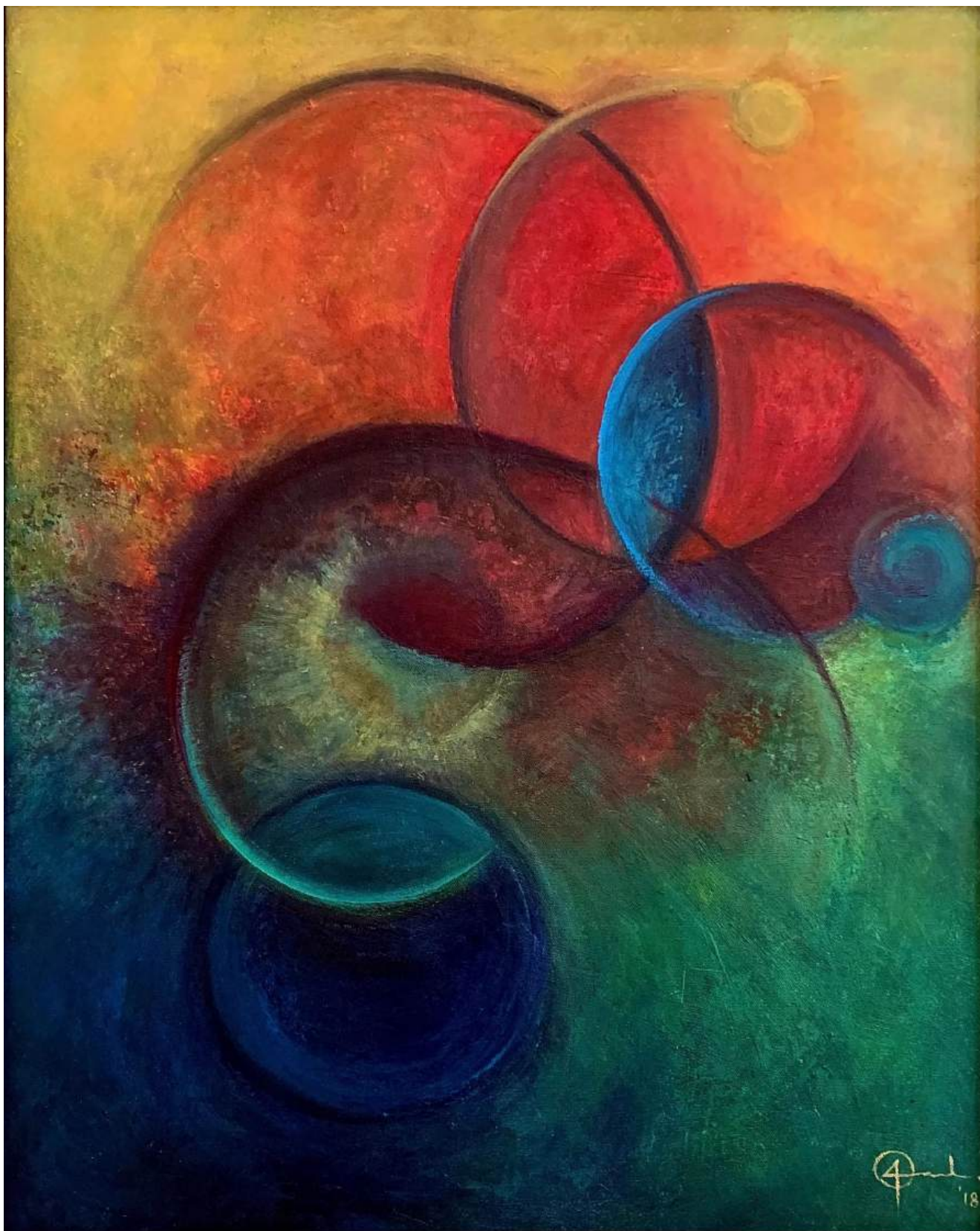

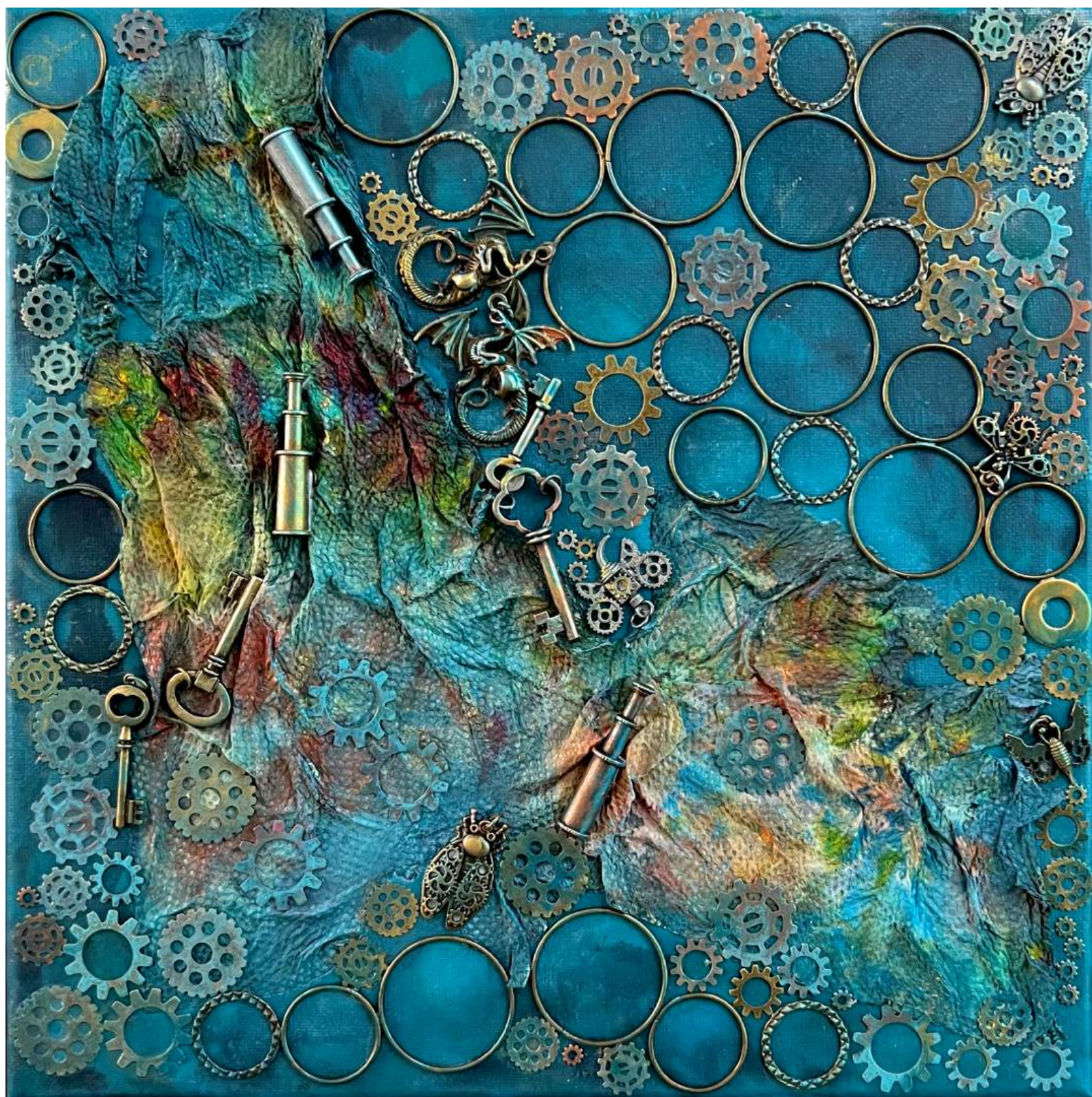

Pamela Encinas is a Mexican-Spanish visual artist born in 1988. Her passion and vocation for the arts began in early childhood, nurtured by a family closely linked to creative disciplines. Surrounded by an artistic environment, she developed a deep sensitivity and curiosity for visual expression. By her teenage years, she was already active as a creative, and in her early twenties, she fully dedicated herself to the fine arts after graduating in Visual and Graphic Arts from the Academy of Fine Arts in Florence, Italy—historically the cradle of artistic heritage—where she lived and worked for nearly a decade.

Her extensive travels and years of living in different countries across Europe and the Americas—including the United Kingdom, Italy, and the United States—have profoundly shaped her perspective and enriched her artistic language. These international personal and professional experiences are reflected in a distinctive visual style that blends cultural influences with an intimate exploration of human emotion and connection.

Pamela's artwork is defined by a bold study of color and intricate detailing, often inspired by the beauty of simple surroundings, nature's forms, and her rich inner imagery. Working across diverse mediums—including painting, watercolor, pastels, collage, assemblage, and other mixed media—she explores dynamic compositions and vibrant narratives. She has also practice techniques in graphic arts, specializing in etching and experimental printmaking, alongside developing a freer approach to photography. In more recent years, she has expanded her creative practice to include illustration and graphic design, integrating traditional and contemporary processes.

Currently based in Houston, Texas, Pamela also divides her time between her beloved Italian Tuscany and her native Mexico lindo, both constant sources of timeless inspiration. Through her daily journeys, she continues to seek new ideas and creative challenges, nourishing what she describes as her “curious and ever-thirsty soul.” Her work has gained recognition in both local and international arenas, with exhibitions at the Holocaust Museum of Houston and the General Consulate of Mexico in Houston, as well as selection in several international art competitions. Today, her pieces are held in numerous private collections abroad, reflecting a growing appreciation for her evocative and vibrant artistic vision.
