

## Lift Kit Warning Discharge Form

Installing a lift kit is a huge investment and process. It will permanently affect the handling of your vehicle and will require more maintenance in the short and long term to maximize the longevity of your investment. Most lift kits require permanent modifications to the chassis of your vehicle.



All of our lift kits have been engineered to pass the FMVSS #126 (Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard NO. 126) by the US dept. of Transportation.

The Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 126 requires that model year 2009, and newer, passenger cars, multipurpose passenger vehicles, trucks, and buses with a GVW rating of 10,000 lbs. or less, must be equipped with Electronic Stability Control (ESC).

ESC systems use automatic computer-controlled braking of individual wheels by controlling engine torque to maintain control in critical driving situations. They control the attitude, weight transfer, and overall traction of your vehicle in case of an emergency.

In part, with a "FMVSS 126 compliant" designation, it indicates that the manufacturer has tested and certified the part to meet the requirements set forth in the safety standard.

### LEGISLATIONS

Each province has their own legislations. For example, a vehicle with more than a 2.5" of suspension lift or body lift is prohibited in the province of Quebec. PEI has limited those modifications to 4" suspension lifts.

In New-Brunswick the only written law as of January 1st 2020 is that the center of the headlights must be lower than 52" from the ground. All provincial authorities have the right to question the integrity or the safety of the vehicle and request that the vehicle needs to pass an engineering inspection by a certified mechanical engineer.

VEHICULE SPEED

Installing different sizes of tires will affect your vehicle speed rating and your instrument cluster might not read accurately. Speedometer can be recalibrated with an aftermarket device.

INSURANCES

Your insurances must be informed of any vehicle modification, otherwise they might deny claims. Most insurances will cover the vehicle without affecting your premium, while others won't insure the vehicle. It's the owner's responsibility to inform his insurance agent.

FUEL CONSUMPTION

A lift kit and oversized tires and wheels will also affect your gas mileage rating due to the undercarriage being higher. That being said, by installing a lift kit, it will drastically affect the EPA ratings of your vehicle.

WARRANTIES

All OEM parts still carry the original manufacturer warranty upon their approval. If in an event such claims are denied both BDS, Zone Offroad ([Factory Protection Plus](#)) and Superlift ([Lift Force Warranty](#)) offer an extra powertrain protection that covers damaged parts only. Labor is not covered by the manufacture and all warranty claims must be approved prior the repairs being done.

BDS, Zone Offroad both carry a lifetime warranty with some exceptions. Some exceptions may be but not limited to wearable parts for example bushings and shocks\*.

Superlift carry a lifetime warranty with some exceptions. Some exceptions may be but not limited to wearable parts for example bushings and shocks\*.

- \*BDS shock absorbers carry 1 year replacement warranty.
- \*Zone Nitro shock absorbers carry 1 year replacement warranty.
- \*Superlift carries a 1 year replacement warranty.
- \*Bilstein carries a limited lifetime warranty.
- \*Fox Racing shock absorbers carry a 1 year repair warranty (coilover shocks must be sent out for rebuild and shipping is at the customers' expense).
- \*King Shox carries a 90 days repair warranty (shocks must be sent out for rebuild and shipping is at the customers' expense).

Labour costs on a warrantable part is never covered by aftermarket manufacturers. As an advantage from buying from Violette Motors Ltd or Violette Ford, we do offer up to 1 year labour warranty on parts sold AND installed by our shop. Plus, we offer a NO-CHARGE lift kit inspection and re-torque during your first oil service after your installation.
