One of our staff members, Kelly, met an international student during a recent day of outreach in the Student Union. The student, N, was sitting alone when Kelly approached. The student agreed and Kelly led her through the various questions regarding life, purpose, and spirituality. It became clear that N had never heard of Jesus and was skeptical that we could have eternal life. N was interested in learning more so Kelly read the Four Spiritual Laws with her. N responded with "I have never heard this before. It is the first time, and I need to learn more." Kelly and N exchanged contact info.
