This week's Team to Beat is Mountain Dew with 1363 total pins!




Coach's Corner

Arrows, Dots, and Boards

This week, we're talking targets. New bowlers tend to look at the pins which are 60 feet from the foul line. Using the arrows gives you a closer target to aim at and it's easier to see whether you hit your mark or not. We number the arrows right to left for righties and left to right for lefties, shown below. A good starting point for a straight bowler is to aim around 3rd arrow. For bowlers that hook the ball, 2nd arrow (on a house shot) is a great starting point. More experienced bowlers will break the lane up into boards (shown below numbered behind the foul line 1-39 and marked every 5 boards at the foul line with a dot). You may hear a coach give the correction of "move your feet 2 boards left/right."
