Alternate Formats for Bowling

A typical team-league format is a certain number of bowlers each throwing a **traditional** game for a team score. We've already bowled **9-pin no tap** this season. This week, we'll be bowling **Scotch Doubles** with adult-kid pairings! The kid will throw the first ball of the first frame and the adult will throw the second. If the kid strikes, the adult will throw the first ball in the second frame. The pair keeps alternating in this way until the game is over. As a visual below, the scores highlighted yellow are the kid and pink are adult!

Baker games are something used at the high school and college level. In a Baker game, 5 bowlers will bowl a single game: one bowler throws the 1st and 6th frames, another the 2nd and 7th frame, etc.
