What's a Washout?

Something I've heard from the kids lately is that they are leaving a split that doesn't show as a split on the scoreboard. While a 1-2-4-10 might look like a split, any spare combination that includes the headpin is not considered a split. Instead, it's called a washout. Leaving a washout when you hook the ball typically indicates that your ball didn't hook enough to get to the pocket (the 1-3 for rightys, and the 1-2 for leftys).

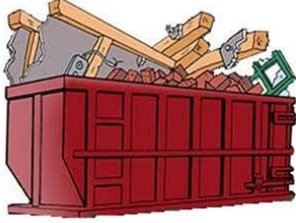
