The Star Spangled Banner

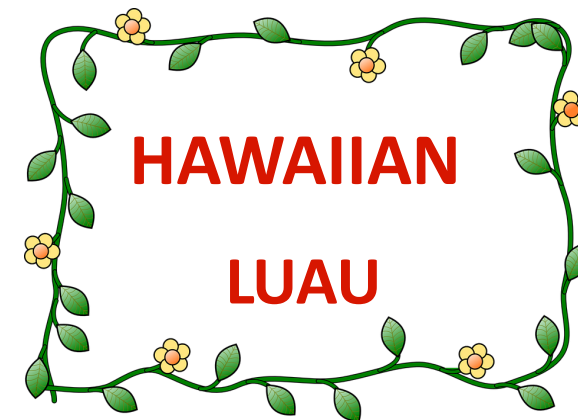
Oh, say can you see, by the dawn’s early light
