

We started our year in April with a lunch get together.


With all the rain and heat we still had many good campouts and lots of good food at our potlucks. We played lots of games and had lots of great times.

Our last camp out for the year will be in October at Lazy Acres Camp Ground in Urbana, Iowa


Our winter lunch together will state in November for the ones that don't go south. Have a safe winter. Looking forward to next year and all the fun we will have
