These are a few of our favorite pet-friendly spaces in St. Marys:

St. Marys History Walk

This 600-foot trail is nestled among shade trees with a view of the St. Marys River. Enjoy a self-guided tour of 24 interpretive panels outlining St. Marys rich history.

Tommy Casey Memorial Dog Park

Fenced in fun for you and your pooch! Proof of rabies vaccination is required upon request. Tag is sufficient.

St. Marys Waterfront Park

The ideal spot from which to watch the shrimp boats come in, take a stroll along the boardwalks and piers, have a picnic, or witness a stunning sunset. Plus, there is a water faucet and built-in dog bowl at the bottom on the amphitheater ramp.

Crooked River State Park

Located on the banks of the Crooked River, this park offers several trails and offers outdoor programming on a regular basis.

St. Marys Welcome Center

Make the welcome center you first stop! Pick up a walking map of the historic district and let us direct you to restaurants, lodging, and attractions.

Sugar Mill Tabby Ruins

The mill was built in 1825. Its rooms which were devoted to the grinding, boiling and processing of cane for sugar products. Picnic areas and restrooms are located on the grounds and this is a stop on the St. Marys Tabby Trail bike trail.

The <u>USS Bancroft Sail Display</u> at the entrance to Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay appears to be a sub skimming the surface. Walk on the sub and take photos.
