- 9. What is the main conflict? Thoroughly explain both internal and external conflict.
- 10. Give a brief summary of the plot.
- 11. What is the resolution? Explain.

- 12. What are major themes of the work? (What truths about life/human nature are revealed?) Give at least two examples.
