

Characteristics (Elements) of Informative Writing (page 298)

Informative writing...

- (1) Informs
- (2) is factual
- (3) is based on research
- (4) is nonfiction
- (5) educates the reader
- (6) cites reliable sources

- (7) has a formal style and objective tone
- (8) includes evidence from a variety of credible sources
- (9) show relationships between ideas with smooth transitions
- (10) has a clear thesis statement

Reliable Sources

- ***Make sure you evaluate your sources.**
- ***Determine if the writer of your resource is an authority on the subject. (Investigate the writer's background, previous publications, and reputation.)**
- ***The information you use should be current.**

- *The publisher of the source should have a good reputation.
- *Other sources should confirm the information that you are using for your research.
