\*The \$10 million for the City of Russellville is in addition to \$5 million Gulfside proposes to pay the City to purchase approximately 20 lakefront acres. If the city does not sell the property to Gulfside, Russellville will receive \$5,000,000, reducing the total Economic Development Agreement to \$60,000,000.
