

# Description

Rose apple is a tropical fruit mainly grown in Southeast Asia. This fruit is very crispy and tasty. The taste of this fruit is similar to an apple, however the flesh of the rose apple is softer than the apple and it has an excellent rose aroma. These fruits are unique in shape. When it comes to rose apple trees, the general height is 20 to 24 feet. The leaves are 7 to 8 inches in length and 2 inches in width.

## Growing Rose Apple From Seeds

### Prepare Soil

- Prepare a container for growing the seeds from recycled materials which would be ideal since the seedlings won't stay for long.
- Add potting mix soil to the container making sure the container has lots of holes for drainage.
- Any soil will do as long as the water drains easily but not quickly and avoid adding fertilizer.

### Plant Apple Seeds

- Poke holes in the soil at least an inch deep.
- Drop the apple seeds in the holes then gently cover with soil.
- Give the soil a good watering to settle the seeds and the soil.

### Transplanting Apple Seedlings

In about two weeks, the seedlings will grow to about two inches tall. The apple seedlings are ready for transplant when they've fully grown and won't be mistaken as weeds out in the open garden.
