The Death and Resurrection Doula Collaboration Association promotes a Christian worldview and standardization of Christian end-of-life doula services. The Association is an **alternative** to The National End of Life Doula Alliance (NEDA.org), a "membership league" and "centralized source" of support for certified End-of-Life Doulas, which considers itself "to be the primary resource for comprehensive and current information about EOLDs." **NEDA does not have any regulatory agency over the end-of-life doula movement.**

Convene Communities is a **Platform with a Purpose**. One platform log-in provides access to training *and* the resources to grow a dynamic ministry. Convene Communities sets the Death and Resurrection Doula Community apart from the other doula training programs.

The Death and Resurrection Doula Collaboration Association is a subscription membership for Death & Resurrection Doulas (\$25/mo).
