Convene Communities is a **Platform with a Purpose**. One platform log-in provides access to training *and* the resources to grow a dynamic ministry. This platform sets the Death and Resurrection Doula community model apart from the other doula training programs. Following Modules 1 & 2 certification, Death and Resurrection Doulas can move on to **The Death and Resurrection Doula Collaboration Association**.

**The Death and Resurrection Doula Collaboration Association** is a subscription membership for certified end-of-life doulas (\$25/mo.). Joining this group will boost your ministry and business development endeavors through continued live support & doula collaboration.

This subscription provides doulas with curriculum additions and changes in the global end-of-life doula movement. **The Death and Resurrection Doula Collaboration Association promotes a Christian worldview and standardization of services** through the Death and Resurrection Doula comprehensive training curriculum, an abbreviated curriculum for doulas certified in other programs (\$450), and robust **continuing education** opportunities. The *Death & Resurrection Doula Support Group* is available to members of the Collaboration Association.

It is an **alternative** to The National End of Life Doula Alliance ([NEDA.org](http://NEDA.org)), a "membership league" and "centralized source" of support for certified End-of-Life Doulas, which considers itself "to be the primary resource for comprehensive and current information about EOLDs." **NEDA does not have any regulatory agency over the end-of-life doula movement.**

**Q/A:**

- 1. What is the goal of the Death and Resurrection Doula Collaboration Association?** The Collaboration Association is vital to the establishment & support of ministries, individual business listings in the State & International directories, and continued fellowship between Death & Resurrection Doula practitioners.
- 2. What is the cost?** The Collaboration Association is a subscription priced at \$25/month. This subscription is purchased by credit card and automatically renewed each month.
- 3. Is membership required?** Joining post-certification is optional, but membership is required to access the benefits of the Collaboration Association. Participating in continuing education events & business development/collaboration will benefit the growth of individual ministries/businesses and the movement as a whole.
- 4. I obtained certification from another program. Can I become a member? Yes!** The abbreviated Orientation Module (\$450) is specifically designed as an easy and affordable way to obtain certification as a Death & Resurrection Doula.
- 5. When does the association meet?** The Collaboration Association meets monthly on the 1st Monday at 7:30 pm EST.
- 6. What is The Death & Resurrection Doula Support Group?** The support group is an integral part of the training program and Collaboration Association. Here you will receive professional guidance in personal spiritual growth as you grow in your role as a Christian end-of-life doula. This group meets monthly on the 3rd Monday at 7:30 pm EST.
