36th ANNUAL SUN CITY OPEN TOURNAMENT RULES

The Sun City Open Senior Tournament is open to all current USBC certified bowlers who are **50 years of age or older as of April 25, 2026.**

- 1) All participants must have a current USBC adult membership card. USBC certification cards will NOT be sold at the tournament site.
- 2) Card carrying members of any professional bowlers' organization shall be limited to two (2) members in the TEAM Event and one (1) member in the DOUBLES event.
- 3) Participants may enter DOUBLES and SINGLES once. Participants may enter the TEAM event up to two (2) times. Participant's ALL EVENTS scores will be based on the first team event bowled plus singles and double scores.
- 4) While multiple participation is permitted in the team event, at least two players on the team must be different in order to place more than once in the prize list for position standings (USBC Rule 315b).
- 5) Participants must enter both SINGLES and DOUBLES events to compete in either. **DOUBLES will be bowled first.** Bowlers will bowl the singles event on the same pair of lanes that the doubles event was bowled.
- 6) Three games will be bowled in each event.
- 7) Bowlers are not permitted to use any ball that has not been released to the general public at the time of the event.
- 8) **AVERAGES:** USBC Rule 319(a1,a), (a2), (a3), (a4), (a5) are applicable for this tournament
 - a) Each bowler will use their highest 2024-2025 average (**Winter OR Summer**) as published in the current book of averages or bowl.com (minimum 21 games). *(When the book average is used and at the time of the tournament an entrant that has a current average for 21 or more games that is 10 pins (or more) higher than the book average, the current average must be used. 319 (a2).)*
 - b) If no 2024-2025 book average is available, the bowler will use the highest average as of April 1, 2026, of 21 games or more. The secretary of the league in which the highest average is being bowled must verify April 1st averages.
 - c) If none of the above requirements are met, the bowler will be assigned an average of 230.
 - d) **Each bowler is responsible for confirming their own average, regardless of whether it was submitted by themselves, the team captain, or another individual.** Failure to use the proper average will result in disqualification if the submitted average is lower than the actual average. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the actual average.
- 9) USBC rule 319c dealing with **AVERAGE ADJUSTMENTS** applies.
 - a) Bowlers with a Sport/PBA Experience/Challenge average (**USBC Certified or not**) from a league using lane conditions other than a normal house pattern will be rerated using the USBC Sport Average Conversion Chart whether the league is USBC Sport Certified or not.
 - b) Tournament Director reserves the right to adjust any average prior to participation to protect the integrity of the tournament. If the assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded.
- 10) USBC rule 319(d) will not apply. It is not necessary to report previous prize winnings.
- 11) Handicap will be based upon 90% of the difference between the entrant's average and 230. Minus handicaps will not be used.
- 12) USBC rules 322a and 322b dealing with **TARDY PLAYERS** applies. Players will not have the opportunity to make up for missed frames and will receive a score of zero for each frame missed
- 13) Cash prizes will be awarded for each event on a handicap basis with no regard to division.
- 14) Entrants not paying the optional All Events fee will not be eligible for cash prizes in the All Events event.
- 15) Prize fees will be returned 100% with a ratio of 1 to 6 in each event (with the exception of All Events, which is 1 to 12)
- 16) All Events entries may be transferred provided such a transfer is made before the bowlers involved have participated in any event of the tournament.
- 17) Substitutions made at the tournament site must complete the entire series in which they substituted. EXAMPLES: Team for Team, Singles and Doubles for Singles and Doubles.
- 18) After an entry is received and the dates assigned by Tournament management, the entry fee will not be refunded. (USBC Rule 314)
- 19) All decisions of the Tournament Director will be final unless an appeal is filed with tournament management (USBC Rule 329)
- 20) To keep the squads on time, one-lane courtesy is requested.
- 21) If space permits, entries will be accepted up to one hour prior to the start of the first squad on April 25, 2026.
- 22) Should the need arise, an overflow squad will be created. A minimum of four teams are required to create an overflow squad.

The current USBC Book of Rules shall govern any rule(s) not covered above

DRESS CODE:

Participation requires participants to dress appropriately and modestly. Attire featuring offensive, disruptive, or inappropriate language or designs is prohibited. Men are required to wear shirts with sleeves. Ultimately, the determination of what is considered suitable attire lies with the Tournament Officials and RCSC Bowling Staff.

- All rules of regular tournament apply.
- All prizes will be awarded based on scratch scores only.
- **You must be entered in regular tournament events to participate in scratch events.**
- The scratch events scores are derived from the regular tournament scores. All scores from regular event will be applied to scratch event. (I.e., Doubles scores apply to scratch doubles, singles for singles etc.) Team scores will be based on the first team event bowled.
- Teams must be the same team as entered in the handicap event, **everyone on the team must be entered in the team event to enter the scratch team event.**
- Doubles teams will be allowed to choose a different team member providing the team member is entered on the same entry form.
- Entry fee is \$10.00 for each event per person.
