You will be asked to complete the following assessments with our staff: Mayo Portland Adaptability Inventory, SLUMs, Quality of Life Inventory (QOLI). We ask your family to complete the Zarit Caregiver Burden Interview and the Family Needs Questionnaire (complete upon admission and every January). Additional assessments may be completed by our occupational therapists, exercise physiologist or speech pathologist. Synapse House may have students in these disciplines that are assigned to complete their field work practicums with us. These students are supervised by their field work coordinator from the university as well as by a Synapse House team member.

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
