CLUBHOUSE DAY HABILITATION PROGRAM

A community-based Day Program for persons with a brain injury or stroke following therapy. Clubhouses are based on one's remaining abilities, not their disabilities. Work of the Clubhouse is real work of the organization and divided into Work Units.

Business Unit: computer training, newsletter

Culinary Unit: meal preparation, grocery shopping, baking

Community Integration: outings, volunteering

EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

Develops the skills needed to return to work, addresses barriers, and provides supported placement & extended job retention services.

COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES

For veterans that served post 9/11, this program assist veterans in gaining independence at home, in the community, as well as providing assistance with return to work and school.

KNZ NEUROFITNESS & GYM

Provides wellness activities, personal training, circuits and exercise groups that are specially designed for those with neurological deficits. Exercise groups are offered virtually as well.

Who should attend?

We serve adults with acquired brain injuries; traumatic injury, stroke, brain tumor, cardiac arrest or progressive diseases. Those served should:

- be able to take their own medications.
- not be at risk of wandering off.
- be able to actively participate without behavioral concerns.
- be able to handle transfer with no more than moderate assistance of one person.

How long can someone attend?

Membership is lifelong. Note that funding sources, other than private pay, may determine the length and/or services provided.

What are the business hours?

Monday through Friday, 8:00am until 4:00pm.
We are closed on major holidays.

What are the fees?

There are four forms of payment.

- Private pay – Please call for the rates
- Department of Rehabilitation Services for Job Coaching, Milestone and Supported Employment Program
- Workers Compensation Insurance
- Brain Injury Medicaid Waiver for those eligible

What about transportation?

Transportation is available. Please inquire about current routes and schedules.
