**WRAC Members**: This program is free to join and requires no additional cost.

**Non-Members**: This program costs \$15/ per month.

The fee non-members pay covers 3 hours/ per week of walking on any day, at any time. Walking also must be done on the walking track NOT on machines for non-members



Are you someone looking to prioritize movement and activity in your life? Or maybe you already participate in weekly movement and activity by walking, using equipment, or other methods. If so, Senior Wellness Walkers might be the group for you!

Join others in the program in logging miles at the WRAC on the walking track, treadmill, elliptical, tread climber, new step, or stationary bike!
