SCHOOL OF THE MONTH! FOREST FIELDS PRIMARY SCHOOL, NOTTINGHAM





Forest Fields Primary School is located in an area of socio-economic disadvantage in the city of Nottingham, with around 40 different languages spoken by its pupils. Sanna Menzano has developed her own teaching career by leading her colleagues to immerse themselves in teaching the ancient world, from a lunchtime Latin club for Year 5 in 2017 to rolling out a whole-school programme for Word Roots last year. The school was one of the first to trial the Vocabulous Word Roots programme and has integrated this across the school into their fortnightly grammar lessons. As well as ancient languages, Forest Fields' pupils have been enriched by the study of Greek mythology, evident from their enthusiastic response to this theme for World Book Day and the story-telling session on the Birth of the Gods delivered with support from CfA by Katy Cawkwell. Sanna continues to seek out new opportunities to engage all Forest Fields pupils with opportunities to learn about the ancient world and its languages, and has encouraged teachers in other schools to follow suit. Many congratulations to Sanna and the team at Forest Fields for their excellent work!

WORD ROOT OF THE MONTH:

Where does our word "Miniature" come from?

I learnt this one recently and was surprised to learn its root! It is not, as I had thought, from "minimus", meaning "very little"! In Italian, "miniatura" was a form of painting, particularly small paintings, from which we get our word "miniature". It ultimately comes from the Latin word "minium" (red lead), which was used to make a red ink for illuminating manuscripts!

In exciting news, Classics for All North will be working with the Great North Museum's Hadrian's Wall Virtual Focus Days, from Tuesday 25th November to Thursday 27th November. The days are for KS2 students in school or home settings, and are free to attend; students can attend all sessions if they'd like (if bookings still allow), or pick and choose which ones they are most interested in.

Classics for All North will be presenting a session about Word Roots along the wall - how can learning about Hadrian's Wall and the military help our understanding of complex English words? 
