





TROPOJE, ALBANIA

Tropoje Region

The District of Tropoje is part of the Kukesi Region in Northeastern Albania. It borders Montenegro (North) and Kosovo (East). Tropoje County consists of 8 administrative units, with the seat of the government located in the city of Bajram Curri. The district of Tropoje is Albania's second largest territory, about 1050 square km. Bajram Curri is around 262 km away from the capital of Albania (Tirana). Tropoje is mountainous, and most of the territory comprises high mountains. Tropoje has a population of approximately 20,000 (while declining rapidly), with about 75% of the population living in rural areas.

Economic Conditions

Though the area is rich in natural resources, limited investments and a lack of hope have forced many people to migrate toward the capital city or foreign countries.

Unemployment remains around 35%, especially among youth, and the most significant income for local families comes from emigration and economic assistance. The state of Kukes has the lowest Gross Domestic Product in the country. Tropoje remains the most underdeveloped area in Albania.

Youth Empowerment

We focus on providing opportunities for young people through programs like the annual Summer Camp, GLOW, Scouts, mentoring, career counseling, and workshops. These initiatives aim to develop leadership, build skills, and guide youth toward sustainable futures.

Through the generous support of our donors, we've enhanced education in Tropoje by providing digital literacy training, computer supplies, and bridging the digital divide for rural students. We've also improved school infrastructure, including upgrading running water and rehabilitating classrooms, creating a better learning environment for all.

YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

The Heart of Community Growth and Collaboration



The youth of Tropoje possess the passion, strength, and vision to lead positive change in their community and Albania. By empowering them through development programs and leadership opportunities, they, in turn, inspire their families and community to grow and thrive together.

For over 5 years, our Summer Camp has served as the cornerstone of this youth development effort, offering 150-200 underprivileged children the chance to access transformative education and social engagement each year. Local community volunteers and educators now run the camp.

The camp's success has catalyzed a broader range of youth initiatives, including the GLOW Club and Scouts groups, which focus on leadership, personal development, and community service. These programs are built on the foundation of strong volunteerism, with both local and international volunteers contributing their time and expertise to create a lasting impact.

Through volunteerism and service-based projects, we've created a network of young leaders who are committed to uplifting their communities. Volunteers from around the world have come to Tropoje, fostering crosscultural exchanges and strengthening the collective drive for positive change. Together, we are not only building a brighter future for youth but also inspiring them to give back through meaningful community service initiatives.

By prioritizing youth development, we are nurturing the next generation of leaders who will continue to shape Tropoje's future. The success of the Summer Camp and its related programs has proven that with the right resources, mentorship, and opportunities, youth can become powerful agents of change, bringing their vision to life for the betterment of their community.

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

GLOW Club

Neda started Girls Leading Our World to empower young girls in Tropoje through leadership development, mentorship, and community service. The club provides a supportive space for girls to grow, learn, and build confidence while positively impacting their community.





Scouts

The Scouts program was created to include younger kids and boys. It focuses on developing leadership skills, teamwork, and outdoor knowledge. Through hands-on experiences and community service, Scouts engage in activities like camping, hiking, and environmental education, all of which promote responsibility and personal growth.

Volunteering

The Tropojan Corps of Volunteers was created to support community service and development initiatives. Volunteers assist with youth programs, education, and local projects, promoting civic responsibility and strengthening the community through active participation.





English

The US Embassy-sponsored program empowered over 200 young people for 2 years by enhancing their communication skills and opening doors to Proficiency global opportunities. It improved their education, career prospects, and ability to connect with international networks, providing valuable personal and professional growth tools.

Engaging young people in organized activities, volunteering, and education is essential for building leadership skills, fostering a sense of responsibility, and improving their career prospects, ultimately empowering them to contribute positively to their communities.

SERVICE PROJECTS

Community service projects for youth foster leadership, responsibility, and a sense of purpose. They contribute to the community while helping young people develop valuable skills. These projects empower the next generation to become engaged, compassionate leaders.



International Volunteers In the past two years, two cohorts of American volunteers from California have worked on service projects with local peers, fostering cross-cultural understanding and providing valuable skills. Their collaboration has strengthened local initiatives.

Youth Impact Young volunteers assist with local infrastructure projects and awareness campaigns, building leadership skills. They play a key role in renovating schools and hospitals and improving community facilities, making a positive impact on their surroundings while developing valuable skills.





Campaign for Cause

Young volunteers organized bake sales to raise funds for various causes and community needs. They engaged peers and residents through teamwork and creativity, positively impacting the community.

Caring for Others

The Scouts and GLOW members raised funds for over three years to purchase backpacks and school supplies for underprivileged children, supporting education initiatives. This was their initiative, proudly supported by their community and parents.





Murals of Hope Youth volunteers painted inspirational murals in schools, kindergartens, and hospital bringing hope and smiles to children and teachers.

EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT



We are dedicated to providing every student with a safe, nurturing, and well-equipped learning environment regardless of financial status.

Our support spans comprehensive school rehabilitation to ensure essential infrastructure like running water, electricity, and technology. Whenever possible, we utilize local resources and labor. The renovation of Kindergarten No. 1 (see photo below) exemplifies our recent school infrastructure initiative.

This project has created a safe and nurturing environment for more than 110 students to learn and play. It is a testament to successful collaboration among various stakeholders, including the community and international donors.

We also promote after-school and extracurricular activities that foster holistic development.

Additionally, we empower educators through training and collaboration with school directors, ensuring all children receive the education and care they deserve.

INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT

School Reconstruction

We advocated for the reconstruction of the rural Llugaj School, securing financial support from the Albanian central government. The school serves over 120 students from kindergarten through 12th grade.





Gym Rehab

The School of Fierze's gymnasium, which serves over 150 students, had been unsafe for 20 years. With a generous donation from LDS Charities, the gym has been fully rehabilitated and is now safe for use.

Sanitation

Thanks to a generous donation from LDS Charities, we improved sanitary conditions at the rural School of Cerrince by rehabilitating its dysfunctional bathrooms. This project benefits over 110 students from kindergarten through 9th grade.





Kindergarten Rehabilitation The kindergarten room at the School of Cerrince was rehabilitated, creating a safe and nurturing environment for over 25 children. Supported by LDS Charities.

School infrastructure improvements ensure that all children, especially those in rural villages and underserved communities, can access safe, conducive learning environments. Proper facilities like functioning classrooms, reliable sanitation, and access to technology are fundamental for students' physical well-being and educational success.




Playground

Several unserved schools in rural villages have benefited from installing playgrounds, providing children with a safe space for physical activity and social interaction. This enhances their health, fosters creativity, and supports emotional and cognitive development.

Heating

Hundreds of heating stoves installed in rural village schools provide a warm learning environment, improving focus, health, and well-being during cold weather.



Dormitory Supplies Provided logistical aid and project support for procuring, transporting, and delivering essential items—such as dishware, appliances, computers, and bedding—to a dormitory for boys and girls from disadvantaged villages in Kukes County. LDS Charities Supported

Libraries

Rehabilitating school libraries and multi-function rooms in Bajram Curri and Cerrince enhances learning environments, fostering creativity and critical thinking. These improvements provide valuable spaces for students and teachers to collaborate and grow.



By supporting these improvements, we help create spaces where children can thrive, engage in their studies, and develop essential skills for their future. Such investments not only enhance the quality of education but also empower entire communities, fostering long-term growth and opportunity.

EDUCATION

Supporting education is crucial as it empowers individuals to reach their potential and drive positive change in their communities. Through Neda's experience as a Health Education volunteer in the Peace Corps, we learned that education not only improves lives but also fosters growth, well-being, and lasting impact.

Technology

Over 80 Chromebooks were lent to underprivileged community-based schools, enhancing access to digital learning. This initiative helps bridge the digital divide, improving students' education and preparing them for future opportunities in an increasingly technology-driven world.





First Aid Kit

First aid kits were provided to over 28 schools in the Tropoje district, ensuring students and staff access to essential medical supplies. California Friends of Albania supported these kits to enhance safety, promote quick responses to injuries, and contribute to a healthier, more secure learning environment.

Teacher Training

Teachers undergo ongoing training on topics such as extracurricular activities, teaching methods, classroom management, and student well-being. These workshops improve teaching skills, boost student engagement, and foster long-term educational success.





Environmental Education

The school installed a greenhouse to provide hands-on learning opportunities for students and teachers. This initiative promotes environmental education, enhances practical skills in agriculture, and fosters a deeper connection to nature and sustainability. New Perspective Supported

Athletic Support

All schools in Tropojë received over 1,500 donated sports jerseys, thanks to our son Coach Shion, a dedicated soccer coach who collected them from universities, high schools, and club teams. His efforts gave local students quality sports gear, fostering school spirit and encouraging youth participation in athletics.

Supporting the underserved

IMPROVING HEALTHCARE

Healthcare and well-being are fundamental rights that should be accessible to all individuals, regardless of their social status, income, or geographic location. Every human being deserves access to basic healthcare services, but particular attention must be given to vulnerable groups, such as the elderly, expectant mothers, and children, who often face heightened health risks due to limited access to resources and care. Adequate healthcare is essential for the physical, mental, and emotional well-being of individuals and is key to enabling communities to thrive and prosper.

In our commitment to improving healthcare access and equity, we have partnered with generous donors to address critical needs within the healthcare system. These efforts have included providing modern medical equipment to our under-resourced hospital, restoring and installing elevators to improve accessibility for patients with mobility challenges, and implementing climate control systems to maintain a safe and comfortable environment for both patients and healthcare workers. These upgrades not only ensure that patients receive highquality care but also foster a positive and supportive environment for healthcare professionals, improving their ability to deliver care effectively.

Our initiatives extend to rural communities, where we have focused on limited infrastructure repairs and improvements in small clinics to ensure they function optimally and provide quality care. By equipping these facilities with a few necessary resources and modern equipment, such as laboratory tools and wheelchairs, we are making healthcare more accessible to even the most remote and underserved populations. These efforts help clinics and hospitals deliver accurate diagnoses, timely treatments, and compassionate care, ensuring fewer people are left behind due to location or financial constraints.



Community Well-being

Our outreach efforts extend beyond healthcare to address the broader well-being of the community, including tackling the issue of stray dogs transmitting diseases to humans and alleviating their suffering. Additionally, through the generous help of donors, we have procured the only functioning fire truck for the largest geographic area outside of Tirana, ensuring critical emergency response services are available to those in need.



Elevator

After 30 years without a functional elevator, the new installation dramatically improves accessibility, especially for those with mobility challenges, and efficiency at Bajram Curri regional hospital. This upgrade enhances patient care and staff operations thanks to LDS Charities' generous support.



Firetruck

The fire truck was generously donated by CWP, significantly enhancing emergency response capabilities in the region. In addition, hundreds of pieces of firefighting equipment were donated by a fire department from California, further strengthening the community's ability to respond to fires and other emergencies effectively.



Stray Dogs

The large number of stray dogs roaming the city has become an epidemic. A pilot project to capture, neuter, vaccinate, medicate, tag, and release them proved successful and received strong community support. As a result, the community is now safer, and the suffering of stray dogs has been greatly reduced. A second pilot program will soon be introduced.

Economic Development

Digital Roots is an initiative designed to empower youth in Tropoje by offering training and job opportunities in digital skills, content creation, and marketing. Through practical learning and mentorship, the program aims to bridge the digital gap, equip young people with essential skills, and foster sustainable employment opportunities for both individuals and the community. Three cohorts have successfully completed the program, with many graduates now working for small enterprises across the EU and the United States.

Local Impact

Digital Roots, now in its third cohort, has trained more than 35 apprentices, about 80% of whom are women from the local community. The program focuses on equipping them with practical skills in digital content creation, marketing, and remote work opportunities, helping them compete in the modern job market. Beyond technical skills, Digital Roots has instilled a deep sense of hope and optimism, especially among young women who now see new possibilities for their future.

For many participants, this opportunity has shifted their perspective—they no longer feel that leaving their country is the only path to success. Instead, they are determined to build careers close to home, remaining connected to their families, culture, and community. Digital Roots is creating not just jobs but a movement of young people committed to staying and contributing to the growth of their hometown.
