REDEVELOPMENT OF UDAGIRINALLAPANAHALLI

Over the last few months, we have successfully completed three houses in Udagirinallappanahalli with another two under construction! These months have been an emotional roller-coaster just dealing with the community and getting the funds to ease out construction. We are hoping to complete six houses soon!







REDEVELOPMENT OF MANDIKAL PANCHAYAT

And, Yes! We have kick-started Redevelopment of Mandikal panchayat! After having identified 10 beneficiaries from Parenahalli, Mandikal and Gudsehalli villages, we have had series of community meetings to arrive at varied design options. Following up, we have started construction at Parenahalli and Mandikal. As of now, we are looking at starting construction at Gudsehalli in a few weeks' time as well! We are using RCC panel and beam system for the roof, and are very excited at the cost effectiveness of the same. Funded by WeRise Foundation, a prototype has been put up in a village in Namgondlu panchayat, we have tested it successfully for different loads and weather conditions over the last few months.
