

This Northern California tour visits *I* three unique areas – the coastal town of Monterey, the cosmospolitan city of San Francisco, and the awe inspiring Redwoods.

DAY 1 – Today we will fly to the Bay Area in Northern California. We will head over to Monterey located on California's rugged central coast. Its Cannery Row, one-time center of the sardine-packing industry, was immortalized by novelist John Steinbeck.

DAY 2 – We will take the famous 17 mile drive today, a scenic road through Pebble Beach and Pacific Grove on the Monterey Peninsula in California, much of which hugs the Pacific coastline and passes famous golf courses, mansions and scenic attractions, including the Lone Cypress, Bird Rock and the 5,300-acre Del Monte Forest of Monterey Cypress trees. In the afternoon, we will spend time at the famous Monterey Bay Aquarium, often voted among the best aquariums and family attractions in the country. There are thousands of marine animals and plants on display in underwater and interactive exhibits.

DAY 3 - We will head to the "City by the Bay" today, San Francisco. A local guide will join our coach and give us a

guided tour of this beautiful city. We'll visit many picturesque sights in this remarkable city, including the Golden Gate Bridge and Lombard Street. Our hotel will be in the Fisherman's Wharf area, so you will be close to many of the sights that have made this one of the greatest cities in the world. You'll be able to explore the area attractions, including Fisherman's Wharf, Pier 39, a historic cable car ride and Ghirardelli Square.

DAY 4 – This morning, we'll take a boat ride and a self-guided tour of Alcatraz Island. This small island, now a national park, was once a fort, a military prison, and a maximum security federal penitentiary. Afterward, we will start heading north to Garberville, our gateway to the Redwoods. We will visit the Korbel Champagne Cellar where we'll have a tour and tasting on the way.

DAY 5 - Today we will drive down the spectacular Avenue of The Giants. This worldfamous scenic drive is a 31-mile portion of old Highway 101 with its 51,222 acres of redwood groves. It is by far the most outstanding display of these giant trees in the entire 500 mile redwood belt.

DAY 6 – We will continue our sightseeing back to the Bay area where we will catch our flight home today.

We'll be exploring and/or staying in some of our most iconic national parks – The Grand Canyon, Bryce Canyon, and Zion. The historic lodges in these parks offer a glimpse into the past, and when staying there, give us a chance to experience a rare treat - the parks without the crowds. Our days will also be full of activities such as a Navajo led tour of Antelope Canyon, a private guided tour of the Zion Canyon Scenic Drive, and a scenic boat ride on Lake Powell. Treat yourself to some historic memories!

DAY 1 - This morning we fly to Las Vegas, Nevada where we will pick up our motorcoach and begin our journey. We'll be spending the night in St. George, Utah.

DAY 2 - Today we finish our drive to the less-traveled North Rim of the awe-inspiring Grand Canyon. This is one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World and we will experience this natural wonder away from the hustle and bustle of the south rim crowds. We'll be visiting the historic Grand Canyon Lodge which sits on the edge of the canyon walls and offers stunning views from the large terrace area as well as through the 4-story glass windows. Later this afternoon, we'll travel to Utah's Little Hollywood, Kanab, where we'll spend the next 2 nights.

DAY 4 – This morning we depart for Bryce Canyon National Park. This park is a natural wonderland of towering spires and colorful, erosion-sculpted rocks called **hoodoos**. We'll be staying in the historic Bryce Canyon Lodge tonight! This gives us all day to take in the amazing geologic formations, join ranger programs, take a sunset stroll on the rim (just a short walk from the lodge), or just relax on your own private porch with your own private fireplace. This area is also one of the best in the country to experience the **night sky**. Be sure to venture outside after dark to enjoy the view.

DAY 5 – Today is again filled with stunning beauty as we venture to Zion National Park through the Zion-Mount Carmel Tunnel. The drive through Zion Canyon is nothing short of spectacular with its towering white, pink and red sandstone cliffs. Climb aboard our guided open-air tram for a private tour along the Zion Canyon Scenic **Drive**. Tonight, we'll be staying at the historic **Zion Lodge** in the heart of the park! Have dinner tonight with a toast to the largest sandstone monoliths right in front of you.

DAY 6 - After a return drive back to Las Vegas, we fly home today after sharing some of our country's most amazing and scenic natural wonders with new friends.

Established as one of Ireland's premier farm experiences, we receive a "warm Irish welcome" and a wonderful insight into farming life both past and present. Enjoy tea and one of their famous scones and watch as the farmer and his dogs herd the sheep. Enjoy the best Hawaii has to offer with visits to the three most popular islands – Maui, Kauai, and Oahu.

DAY 1 - This morning we will fly to the **Hawaiian Islands**, our 50th state. We will start our tour on the **island of Maui**, the Valley Isle at the resort area of **Kaanapali** where we'll spend the next 3 nights.

DAY 2 – We will start this morning by visiting one of the most scenic spots in Maui. The **Iao Valley State Park**, nicknamed Yosemite of the Pacific, a lush tropical landscape. You will see the **Iao Needle**, a spire that rises 1200 feet from the valley floor. Then for a real taste of Hawaii. And by taste, I mean you will sample 14 of Hawaii's most popular fruits at the **Maui Tropical Plantation** and store. We will take a tram tour of the 60 acres of papaya, guava, mango, taro, macadamia nuts, and coffee. This is a great chance to ship some of these delights back home. On our way home, we will visit **Lahaina**. We will arrive back in time to put on our best Hawaiian attire and join the festivities at Maui's

festivities at Maui's number one **Luau**. Fortunately for us, this is located at our hotel on our very own beach.

DAY 3 – Today will be a **free day** to do as you please. A trip up to see the sunrise at Haleakala may be in order, a round of golf, hanging out at the beach or shopping at Whaler's Village

or Lahaina. We can help you plan your activities. One of the most popular excursions we can plan for the group is the road to Hana. This is an all-day adventure that will take you to some of the most beautiful and remote parts of Maui.

DAY 4 - After checking out of the hotel, we will head to the North shore of **Maui** and visit the world famous wind surfing beach at **Ho'okipa Beach Park**. Watch as locals and professional surfers take on the giant waves. Grab a lunch and explore the shops at the quaint town of **Paia** before heading to the airport. This afternoon we will be flying to the **island of Kauai** where we'll be staying the next 2 nights.

DAY 5 – Kauai is known as the "Garden Isle" and you will see that first hand today. Our first stop will be the spectacular **Spouting Horn Blowhole**, one of the most photographed spots on Kauai. The Poipu surf channels into a natural lava tube here and releases a huge spout of water that can reach as high as 50 feet into the air. Then it's off to see the beautiful **Waimea Canyon**, also referenced as the Grand Canyon of the Pacific. The canyon is 10 miles long and 3,600 feet deep and is a sight to see.

DAY 6 – This morning we will take a **boat ride** and see the **Fern Grotto**, an unusual fern-covered cave set in a tropical garden. This afternoon we will fly to the island of **Oahu** where we'll be staying the next 2 nights in the heart of **Waikiki**.

DAY 7 - Today will be a **free day** to do as you please. Your escort will be available in the morning to help you plan your activities. There are many things to do while in Oahu. A great choice would be to visit the **Polynesian Cultural Center**. Arts, craft, dance and music of the Pacific Islanders are presented. Included in the package is the canoe pageant, a narrated tram tour, a Hawaiian film, buffet dinner, and the spectacular evening show. Or you may want to visit the Battleship Missouri or fly to another island for the day to see a Volcano.

DAY 8/9 - Today we will have a **guided city tour** where we'll see sights like **Punchbowl** and downtown **Honolulu**, the capitol of Hawaii. Besides seeing our Nation's capitol, this tour explores the surrounding areas of Williamsburg. As an added bonus we will enjoy the beautiful fall weather and small crowds.

DAY 1 - We will depart Colorado this morning and fly to Washington DC. A motorcoach will be waiting for us when we arrive. We kick off our tour with a nighttime tour of the illuminated monuments. This week we will visit most of the memorials including the Washington Monument, the Jefferson, Lincoln, and Vietnam Veterans Memorials. These visits will be at various times throughout the tour.

DAY 2 - We start our day with a tour the Arlington National Cemetery which includes the Kennedy grave sites, changing of the guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Challenger Grave site and Arlington House. This afternoon we will make our first visit to the Smithsonian Mall area. We will be centrally located and there are nine great museums to choose. You might want to start your exploration with the National Air and Space Museum. A short walk from the Mall for those that want to visit, is the Holocaust Museum. One of the most informative and moving museums you will ever experience.

DAY 3 – Climb aboard the Spirit of Mount Vernon for a relaxing 45-minute sightseeing cruise. As you travel north on the Potomac, hear stories of the people and animals who have inhabited its shores throughout history, including Native Americans, fish, and bald eagles. Pass by the imposing Fort Washington in Maryland and learn about the river's role in the Civil War. Our destination will be Mount Vernon, the estate and burial place of George Washington. We will see the preserved mansion, stables, kitchen and garden. In the afternoon, we will get a chance to visit more of the famous Memorials

DAY 4 - This morning we will visit the Smithsonian Mall again, checking out the **Museum of Natural History**. You can also walk to any of the other museums you prefer. In the afternoon, we will leave Washington and travel near Williamsburg where we will spend the next 2 nights.

DAY 5 – Today we will spend the day in Colonial Williamsburg. You will experience life in the 18th century at America's largest outdoor history museum. There will be a guided tour followed by a colonial style lunch (included) at a local tavern. The afternoon will have some time for you to explore the town on your own.

Call the Falcon Tours office and check for availability. Provide your name, address, phone number and number in your party. In order to hold your reservation, the deposit is due within 7 days of making a reservation. Your cancelled check is your receipt. A balance letter will be sent to you 30-45 days before the tour showing your balance owed and the final itinerary with hotel phone numbers.

What to expect with Falcon Tours:

Falcon Tours has been providing deluxe motorcoach tours across the country from Colorado since 1995. All Falcon Tours are escorted by a trained professional. We select quality hotels and enjoyable entertainment along the way to make your tour experience a memorable one. During motorcoach travel, seats are rotated every day and we stop every 2 to 2 1/2 hours for a break. For the comfort of others, there is no smoking on the motorcoach.

Group Leaders:

If you organize a group of 15 or more the group leader goes free!

What's included in the price:

The tour price includes motorcoach transportation as we travel from place to place, airfare to our destination for fly tours, hotel stays, all activities listed, meals listed, and a professional tour escort. Regarding meals, we try to choose locations that have several choices. To keep your tour cost down, we only include special meals and let you budget the remainder. We try to stay at hotels that have restaurants nearby and have free continental breakfasts.

Refunds:

Refunds will be given, minus costs not refunded to Falcon Tours, if cancellations are received at least 30 days prior to tour departure. A \$100 handling fee may be added to all cancellations after a deposit is made. Cancellations to fly/drive tours may result in cost of airline tickets not being refunded.
