Besides seeing our Nation's capitol, this tour explores the surrounding areas of Williamsburg. As an added bonus we will enjoy the beautiful fall weather and small crowds.

- DAY 1 We will depart Colorado this morning and fly to **Washington DC**. A motorcoach will be waiting for us when we arrive. We kick off our tour with a **nighttime tour** of the illuminated monuments. This week we will visit most of the memorials including the **Washington Monument, the Jefferson, Lincoln, and Vietnam Veterans Memorials.** These visits will be at various times throughout the tour.
- DAY 2 We start our day with a tour the **Arlington National Cemetery** which includes the Kennedy grave sites, changing of the guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Challenger Grave site and Arlington House. This afternoon we will make our first visit to the **Smithsonian Mall** area. We will be centrally located and there are nine great museums to choose. You might want to start your exploration with the **National Air and Space Museum.** A short walk from the Mall for those that want to visit, is the **Holocaust Museum.** One of the most informative and moving museums you will ever experience.
- DAY 3 Climb aboard the Spirit of Mount Vernon for a relaxing 45-minute sightseeing cruise. As you travel north on the Potomac, hear stories of the people and animals who have inhabited its shores throughout history, including Native Americans, fish, and bald eagles. Pass by the imposing Fort Washington in Maryland and learn about the river's role in the Civil War. Our destination will be **Mount Vernon**, the estate and burial place of George Washington. We will see the preserved mansion, stables, kitchen and garden. In the afternoon, we will get a chance to visit more of the famous Memorials
- DAY 4 This morning we will visit the Smithsonian Mall again, checking out the **Museum of Natural History**. You can also walk to any of the other museums you prefer. In the afternoon, we will leave Washington and travel near Williamsburg where we will spend the next 2 nights.
- DAY 5 Today we will spend the day in **Colonial Williamsburg**. You will experience life in the 18th century at America's largest outdoor history museum. In the morning, there will be a **guided tour** followed by a **colonial style lunch (included)** at a local tavern. The afternoon will have some time for you to explore the town on your own.
- DAY 6 Today we will travel back to DC to fly home to Colorado.
