The beauty of Alaska is overwhelming. Wildlife is abundant. The pampered life awaits you. Wonderful food, entertaining shows, fun activities, and beautiful views of Glaciers and snow-capped mountains will keep you entertained. This itinerary is unique in that it includes Glacier National Park! Cruise ports of call include Juneau, Skagway, Ketchikan, and Victoria.

DAY 1- Today we fly to Seattle, Washington where we'll spend the night prior to our cruise.

DAY 2 – We will enjoy a **city tour** today prior to boarding the **Emerald Princess** this afternoon.

DAY 3 – Today is a **sea day**. You can relax as we sail north to Alaska. There are numerous activities all over the ship. The tricky part is trying to decide which ones to do!

DAY 4 – Our port of call today is Alaska's capital city, **Juneau**. This amazing city is landlocked – you can only get here by boat or plane! There are guided excursions or plenty to see as you walk around the town including the capital building.

DAY 5 – Our port of call today and see the city of **Skagway**, Klondike gold rush territory. There are many guided excursions, like the White Pass and Yukon train or a trip to the Eagle Preserve in Haines. Or you can just walk around the town on your own.

DAY 6 – Today we will cruise through **Glacier Bay National Park**. This park is one of the most scenic spots in Alaska. The bay, about 60 miles long and up to 10 miles wide, was filled with ice 5,000 feet thick as recently as 200 years ago. Glacier calving is a sight to see at **Marjorie Glacier**. A **national park ranger** will board the boat and be narrating as we pass through.

DAY 7 – Our last Alaska port of call is **Ketchikan**, also known as the salmon capital of the world. The town is five miles long and a half-mile wide and is Alaska's southernmost city. Walk along Creek Street, a historical area which has shops and museums and is built up over the water. Or enjoy a guided excursion like fishing or bear watching.

DAY 8 – Our port of call today is **Victoria, Canada**. You might want to visit the famous Buchart Gardens or just walk around the town. We will be in port late so you'll see the beautiful Legislative Buildings which are illuminated by 3,000 light bulbs.

DAY 9 – We will back to Seattle this morning where we'll head to the airport for our flight home.

The price above includes Airfare, Hotels, Transportation from Airport to Hotel, Transfers to/from Ship, Port Charges, and Inside Room on Ship. While on the ship, all food is included.
