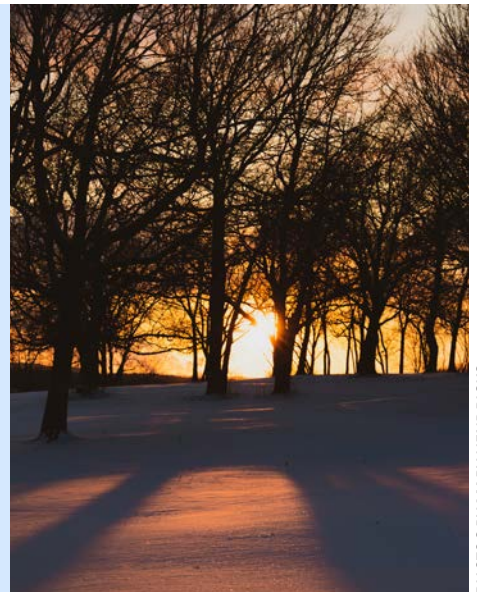
see if they will partner with you in this work. Also let me know if you know someone who we should reach out to for a partner.

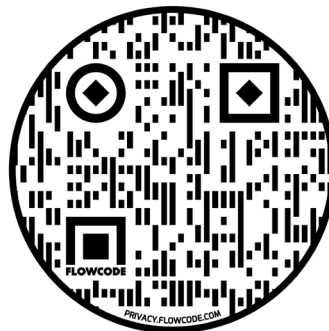

Their goal is to not only raise money for healing for children and families impacted by trauma, but also to ensure they are bringing quality merchandise to their customers.

The furniture and larger items are managed by our warehouse manager, Mr. Mike Bejarano. Mike and his wife Lisa have been with Hope Harbor for 20 years in August and they each have served in a few different roles over the years. It is a rare moment to catch Mike when he is not hard at work. He is dedicated and passionate about being helpful in any way he can be.

Thrift Harbor also is very proud to be part of the Claremore community. The store serves many Claremore families throughout Rogers county as well as working with the Rogers County Court House as a "second chance" location for men and woman who are trying to improve themselves and their lives. "We all deserve a second chance." Kim said. "We all fall short sometimes and we need to pull each other up when we can. My hope is that Thrift Harbor is a place people feel comfortable to begin a fresh start."

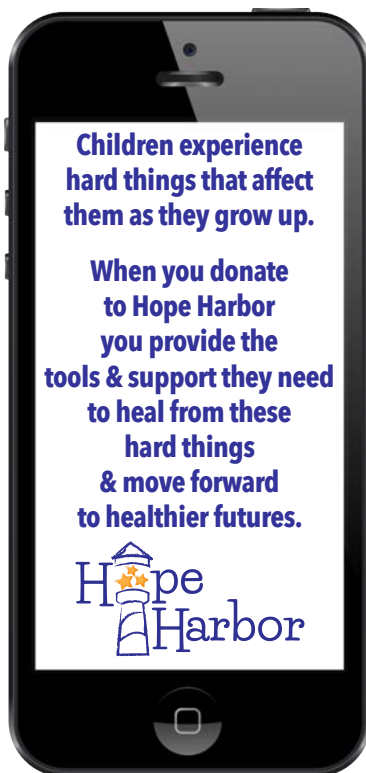
