The children at Hope Harbor are not here because they have no families or their families do not want them. Rather, they are here because their families are asking for help. Help for their child to heal from traumatic events. Help for the parents to connect with them and overcome the impact of trauma in their family. Help to be the support system their child needs to become a productive member of society.

The heartbeat of Hope Harbor is Connection. We utilize Trust-Based Relationship Intervention (TBRI) and other evidence-based practices as we walk with children and families on their journey toward healing. Our foundation, and our history, are tied to the importance of faith and family.

Since 1947, Hope Harbor (formerly Turley Children's Home) has been a place where committed donors offer hurting families connection to God and other people.

Cottage life is home-like, warm, and safe. Our House Parents are trained professionals who provide a positive environment for children, and offer the opportunity to try new patterns and behaviors. Our Academy features low student:teacher ratios, the opportunity to connect with teachers, and learn to love learning again, or even for the first time.

Our counseling services are provided by licensed mental health professionals, and are evidence-based; our counseling staff are also TBRI practitioners. Every child participates in individual, group, and family counseling.

Our program is deeply rooted in family work. We believe the connection to family is among the most important connections in life, and is the foundation of growth and healing. Children do not participate in our program alone-every family commits to walking this path together, leading to change for the entire family.
