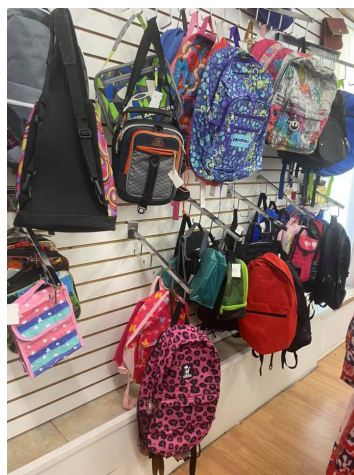

When children's bodies suffer emotional trauma, it often leads to physical ailments down the road. **10% of children in the United States have a 3x higher chance of heart disease and cancer, because of traumatic events they experienced.*** Children who experienced multiple traumatic events have a 20-year shorter life expectancy than other children.

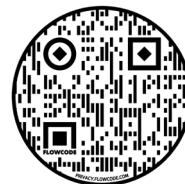

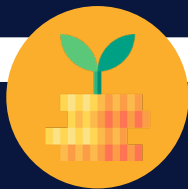
