




A Peek into the Life of a Residential Life Specialist

s we hit our 6 month mark of being Residential Life Specialists at Hope Harbor, we're realizing that being House Parents is not just our job: it's our passion, our livelihood, and our ministry. The day-to-day necessities in meeting the basic needs of 6 girls doesn't even begin to cut into the heart of the work here.

It's the conversation on the front porch with a girl, listening as she struggles through the choices for her future. It's mediating between two roommates, as they learn to create boundaries and mutual respect for each other's space for the first time in their lives. It's shooting

off quick texts and emails to a supervisor about incidents throughout the week, so each girl's parents can be emailed and kept in the loop as much as possible. It's hiding your surprise when one of the girls asks if she can say the prayer before dinner for the first time ever. It's holding in the tears until you get to go to your private apartment at night. It's finding the perfect balance in structure and consistency, while trying to add in some fun memories and new experiences. It's making sure your own kids and marriage don't get put last on the list of priorities each day. It's looking at the hurt and anger from a past incident and not taking the unexpected outburst from a girl personally. It's turning to your co-workers for help when a girl asks about being baptized and you feel ill-equipped to walk them down the path to such a life-changing decision by yourself. It's admitting when you're emotionally maxed out and need a break.

Hope Harbor isn't a place with quick fixes and perfect staff. It's a place with tools to help you work through the "impossible" and a group of people who understand that you're human.

It's a place of hope. And we couldn't be more honored to be a part of it.
