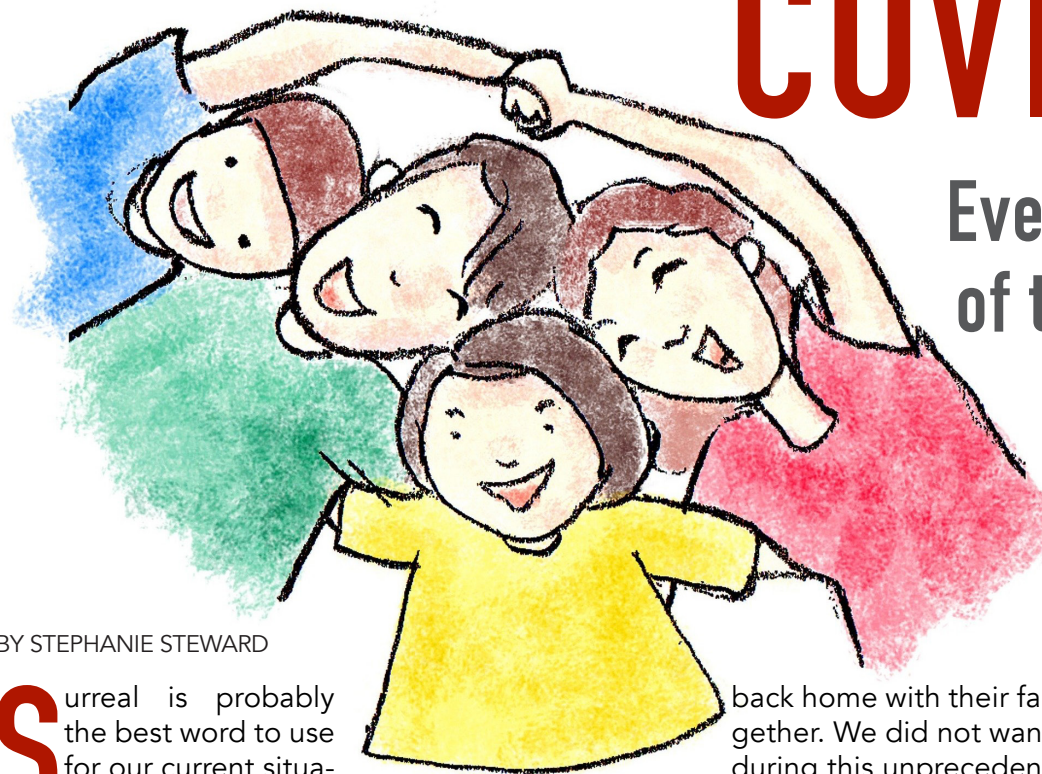


Helping Hand
