October 7, 2024 Meeting called to order at 7 pm

Pledge of Allegiance

### **Correspondences:**

Rosebrugh spoke on sharing the cost of brine to Peter's Rd. We will get pricing in the spring from Road Commission.

**Public Comment:** Wilgus asked if Lake Ogemaw would be getting the ultra-thin asphalt applied this Fall. Supervisor told him it all depends on the Road Commission schedule, the request is in.

### **New Business. Accurate Pest Control**

Motion Carried to have the Township hall sprayed for the pest-bugs.

### **Unfinished Business: ARPA Projects- final report**

Motion Carried to have the final ARPA projects be Twp. Hall bathroom update with a mop sink, painting the hall heat vents & Township ground improvements.

### **Reports:**

**Supervisor** told the Board the New sign at the cemetery is up& looks great. Also paid with ARPA funds. He informed the Board that our Commissioner will not be attending Twp. Meetings unless we call & request her to be present. He told the Board that Commissioner will not answer the public's questions at the County meetings. More discussions on the County jail, Sheriff Road patrol issues at the County level.

**Clerk** reported she had 371 requests for Absent Voting Ballots. The public test is on Oct. 23<sup>rd</sup> at 5pm.

**Treasurer** reported to the Board that she mailed 127 tax reminders and got 60 payments back- she felt worth the time taken for the extra mailing. She will need new information from Board member for the upcoming Newsletter.

She said we had an issue at free dump day on charging for tires.

Rosebrugh stated there is a grant we can write to help offset the cost of the tires- he'll get us the information.

Trustee Quigley told the Board the Commissioners vote not to take a pay raise & also not to give pay raises to elected officials due to the budget shortages. With the County budget they are dealing with 3 different unions.

Part of the Revenue shortage is due to the sheriff not having a traffic car on I-75 for tickets-which also hurts the public libraries.

A motion was made Lauria and seconded by Babcock to pay the bills. **Motion Carried.**
