Three year starters Dan Martelle, Jeremy Matte, Dan Wrubleski, Jay Arnold, Anthony Sprague and two year starter Mike Hazen graduated. They leave behind a three-year run never before reached in the annals of our school. Their three-year league record was 36-6 with two league championships and their overall record was 59-16 with two Section II titles and one New York State Regional Title. They had the opportunity to play on beautiful and historical fields such as Doubleday Field in Cooperstown, Bleecker Stadium and Heritage Park in Albany, and Harmon Field in Herkimer at the State Championship Tournament. They leave behind a legacy of rewards that may never be matched. Dan Martelle became the all-time leader in hits and RBI's at HFCS. The team is looking forward to sectional play and to the return of several outstanding underclassmen for the 1998-99 season.


Once again, Panther Wrestling is having a great season. The team is gaining statewide recognition and is currently ranked third in the State in Class C and D.






The VAGABOND

In our research we also found that up to 1974 the nickname for our school was the Hoosiers. Write-ups in the 1974 yearbook interchanged the name Hoosiers and Panthers. When asked how our yearbook was named 'The Vagabond,' Dr. Reed responded that 'The Vagabond' was selected to represent a book that would go around the world with graduates.

We, the editorial staff of The 1998 Vagabond, are proud to carry on the tradition of The Vagabond, and encourage future yearbook staffs to keep the name and to use the drawing of the Vagabond somewhere in the book.
