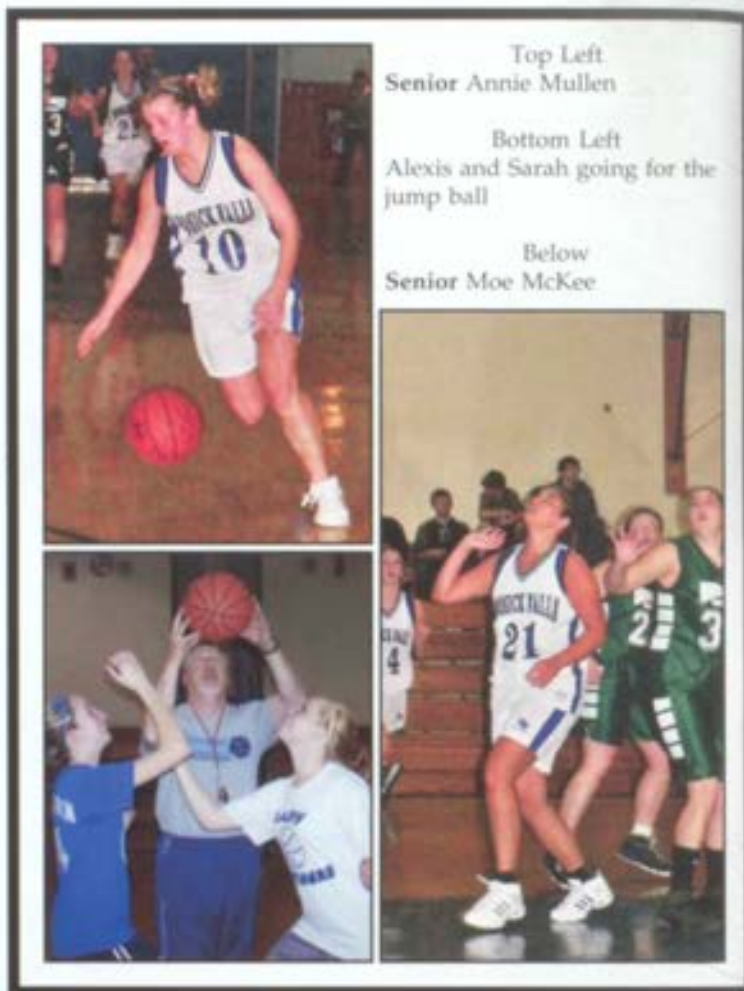
Girls' Basketball
