Dear Students,











Terror in Paris

On January 7th the office of a French magazine was attacked by Islamic militants. During this horrific event twelve people were shot and killed. Only two days after these events the men responsible for the attack were located and killed by the police, but apparently they had not yet had their fill of bloodshed, for four people who were being held hostage in a kosher shop lost their lives as well. What was the reason behind all of this violence? The French magazine that goes by the name of *Charlie Hebdo* created cartoons depicting some fairly serious news stories. Apparently the magazine also had no qualms about depicting religious stereotypes, predominately Islamic ones. It is a violation of Muslim laws to depict the Prophet Muhammad in any way, be it a picture, a drawing, or even an actor playing a role. Unfortunately there exist a small number of backward individuals who believe such a violation should be punished with death. Extremist Muslims such as these found the cartoons to be derogatory and threatened to attack the magazine if it proceeded to print the cartoons. The magazine, in turn, decided to ignore the threats, saying it had the right to print whatever it pleases, and this past week those militants carried out their bloody threat. This conflict brought about intensive debate over the subject of free speech. People from all over the world have demonstrated their unyielding support, defending the magazine's right to free speech. Many showed their support on the internet by sharing illustrations of their own, displaying the message, "*Je suis Charlie*" which translates to "I am Charlie." Others simply posted messages in memory of those who were killed. Even world leaders have spoken out about the right to free speech and how it must be defended. This attack has been called "a direct assault on democracy," by the head of the United Nations Ban Ki-moon.

A week after the attack, the magazine has been up and running, the normal print run usually averages around 60,000, the latest run has been extended to five million copies. The copies were printed in six languages including English, Arabic, and Turkish, all proceeds went towards the victims' families. The "survivor's issue" has also decided to embrace its right to free speech by depicting the Prophet Muhammad on its cover. On the cover the Prophet Muhammad is weeping while holding a sign reading "I am Charlie," below the headline reads "All is forgiven."

Republicans Win Big in US Midterm Elections

On November 4th, the 2014 National Midterm Elections were held. Every two years, one third of the Senate is up for reelection. This year was most influential as at the end of polling, Republicans came out on top and will now take control of both the House of Representatives and the Senate, conditions which are potentially problematic for President Obama and his party. Commentators argue that the influx of Republicans into the Senate is due to dissatisfaction with President Obama and the "gridlock" that currently exists in the government. Most likely though, people have been governed under Obama for nearly two terms see little change for America and they have resorted to inducing a more Republican-style government rather than enforcing Obama's Democratic stance. Most of governmental flaws as of late have been blamed on the Democratic Party as they are currently in control of the White House under Obama.

The result of the midterm elections by means that the government will be split for the last two years of Obama's presidency and that both Houses of Congress will consist of the opposing party.

The switch towards the Republican Party was not only prominent in the Senate, but also overtook the entire country which as a whole seemed to elect Republican candidates to office. Thanks to these elections, Mitch McConnell will now replace Harry Reid as leader of the Senate, further securing the Republican stronghold of the House and the Senate. On the New York side of the elections, the state also emerged primarily Republican, with the exception of Governor Andrew Cuomo, a Democrat, who took over half of the overall votes coming in at 53.98%.

The elections would seemingly imply that, overall, the country has now identified itself mainly with the Republican Party, whether that is due to Democrat President Obama's lack of change, or that the U.S. is becoming a more conservative nation remains to be seen. The results of this election could potentially cause problems in the Congress in the near future as the government is now overrun with Republican power, but seated by a Democratic president. Only time will tell.

ISIS Executes Another American as Joint International Containment Efforts Stall

ISIS has struck again. The White House confirmed that this past weekend, American aid worker Peter Kassig became the fifth westerner to be beheaded by the radical militant group in Syria. He was killed along with twelve captive Syrian soldiers. Similar to the other beheadings, the world responded in horror and is once again outraged, with some people calling for more air strikes on the region.

Since the US-led air strikes began, there has been an influx of conflicting information on whether or not they are working. The terrorist group has not expanded from the territory it controls in northern and western Iraq and northeastern Syria, but it has not lost land either. The United States, Saudi Arabia, Jordan, United Arab Emirates, Bahrain, and Qatar have all targeted ISIS supply lines and buildings where its leaders are said to be living, in an attempt to minimize the amount of civilian deaths from the air. Top military commanders are reporting that ISIS is exhibiting signs of stress and disorder, but it is now hard to tell with the recent killings.

ISIS, a group of radical Sunni Muslims, is trying to set up an area in the Middle East that will be governed solely by Sharia law. Islam is split into two different sects, the Sunnis, and the Shias. When the prophet Muhammad died, it was unclear who should lead the Muslim community, leading to a split in the religion. The majority of Muslims are Sunni and are the more orthodox of the two groups, as they live by a very strict interpretation of the Koran. The Shia are considered to be a minority and have a hierarchy of clerics who interpret and preach Islam. They are viewed as more of a political group. The majority of the people in the domain of ISIS are Sunnis, but are rebelling because of the conditions that are being imposed both by the Iraqi and Syrian government and ISIS. This had led to the influx of Syrian and Iraqi refugees into Turkey and other neighboring countries.

Ebola Outbreak


According to the Centers for Disease Control reports that the 2014 Ebola epidemic is the largest in history. It has been found in multiple countries in West Africa.
