## Message from the Principal.....


Dear Students,









# Students Speak

## OCCUPATION OREGON

Lately in the news, there have been some pretty confusing stories involving Oregon, and if you're anything like me, you're confused. Wait, so some ranchers took over a federal building, and now they're just... living there? Well, sort of, but there's much more to the story than that. In this article I will try and answer the most common questions being asked about this incident.

**Wait- so what's going on?** On January 2nd, an extremist group of armed men- mostly ranchers, who call themselves the Citizens of Constitutional Freedom- broke into the wildlife refuge headquarters located in Burns, Oregon. The leader of the group, Ammon Bundy, stated that they would not leave the premises until "the government had stopped its tyranny." Ammon Bundy is the son of Cliven Bundy, an anti-government proponent who made the news back in 2014 for an armed standoff against the feds, which occurred after the government attempted to make him move his cattle off of federally owned land. Cliven stirred up even more controversy in the media after the armed shootout when he wondered aloud to a news reporter "if black people would be better off enslaved" during an interview. As of today (January 12th), Ammon Bundy and an unknown number of armed men (and possibly a few women) remain in the refuge headquarters.

**What do they want?** Well, they have not made that too clear yet. Ammon told reporters that they wanted the federal government to surrender the wildlife refuge headquarters to the Citizens of Constitutional Freedom so that they could "reclaim their resources" - a goal that Ammon did not go on to explain in detail. The group's second goal is to earn justice for Dwight and Steven Hammond, two ranchers convicted of arson of federal land back in 2012. The Hammonds claimed that they started the fire on their own land to clear out invasive plant species, but prosecutors had testimonies from witnesses that said the fire was used to hide the evidence of the Hammonds' illegal poaching of deer. The fire spread out of control and burned acres of federally-owned land. The case was first ruled on by a federal judge who ruled that the five-year minimum sentence for the crime was too harsh, and instead sentenced Dwight Hammond to three months and Steve Hammond to two 12-month sentences, which they both fulfilled. However, in October 2015, the U.S. Court of Appeals reopened the case and ruled that the Hammonds had to serve the minimum five year sentence- meaning that they were technically sentenced twice for their crime. Ammon called this incident "evidence of the government's abuse of power" and is citing it as a large part of the motivation to capture the wildlife refuge building. The Hammonds, currently in prison, are not participating, and their attorney has stated that they do not support Bundy's actions.

**Why isn't law enforcement stepping in?** The wildlife refuge center is located in the middle of nowhere; it's a relatively small building surrounded by miles of wide open fields on every side. An intervention of any kind by the law enforcement could be disastrous, particularly because there is almost no information on who is there, or what kind of weapons they have. The FBI is in control of the situation, and are hoping for a peaceful resolution to be reached. There is reason to believe that the group has intention of violence if provoked by law enforcement. Ryan Payne, who was part of the shootout between Cliven Bundy and the feds in 2014, told the Southern Poverty Law Center (an organization which deals with hate crimes) that he had been in charge of "putting snipers in position" around the refuge.

Particularly on Twitter, this nonviolent approach is being criticized. Many people are tweeting #OregonUnderAttack along with #BlackLivesMatter, claiming that if Bundy and his followers were all black, or all Muslims, instead of all white, a swifter and more violent course of action would have been taken to stop the standoff from continuing.

**So what happens now?** Bundy has stated that the group is prepared to occupy the building for months, until their demands have been met. "We have enough food and supplies," he said, "to see us through for a long time." Bundy also continues to recruit support on social media, a method that he used to gather the group currently sieging the wildlife refuge center. Despite the fact that many of the men that are confirmed to be part of the standoff are known to be anti-Muslim or anti-black, Bundy has invited anyone against the government to join the standoff. He noted that the group had no intention to harm anyone, but if the law enforcement did try to stop them, they would defend themselves.

**Update:**

The *Washington Post* reported that a federal judge ordered the continued detention of five men who were key players in the nearly month-long armed occupation of the Malheur National Wildlife Refuge in eastern Oregon.

rejecting arguments that the occupation was similar to the Boston Tea Party or civil rights era protests. "From Day One they were breaking the law - they made no secret they were breaking the law," said U.S. Magistrate Judge Stacie F. Beckerman. "I reject the argument that this was a peaceful operation based on freedom of speech."

Beckerman denied release to Ammon Bundy, Ryan Bundy, Jason Patrick, Ryan Payne and Dylan Anderson, all of whom were central players in the occupation of the wildlife refuge. Ammon and Ryan Bundy, sons of Nevada rancher Cliven Bundy, were the leaders of the occupation, which started as a defense of two jailed ranchers but turned into a larger protest over the role of the federal government in people's lives. They were both arrested and LaVoy Finicum, one of the occupation's chief spokesmen, was fatally shot by an Oregon State Trooper during the highway operation.

## GUN CONTROL

The deadly shooting of 20 students and six staff members at a Connecticut elementary school did not prompt Congress to pass a single bill to address gun violence. Congress did nothing after high-profile shootings at a military base, in a movie theater, at a church and on a college campus. Even when a congresswoman from Arizona was shot in the head during a public meeting with constituents, Congress refused to take action.

The President of the United States wept last Tuesday. He wept when he came to the part of his speech about children. "First-graders!" he said. "Every time I think about those kids, it gets me mad." On Wednesday, January 16, President Obama introduced a number of reforms aimed at reducing gun violence, both through executive order (presidential decrees that bypass Congress). By approaching gun control, a contentious and largely untouchable issue in American politics, Obama has shown that occasionally, politics may be fueled by passion, as opposed to popularity.

President Obama has been adamant about gun reforms ever since Sandy Hook, the 2012 school massacre in Newtown, Connecticut - a tragedy which renewed the long-dormant debate over gun control.

The reforms enacted in 2013, which were largely inspired by the Sandy Hook massacre, placed a clear emphasis on preventing mass shootings (events for which the U.S.'s rate is eight times higher than other countries). While mass shootings are traumatizing, tragic, and highly newsworthy, they do not constitute the large majority of gun deaths in our nation. Out of the approximately 8,700 homicides committed yearly with firearms, victims of mass shootings regularly constitute less than 100 deaths; this is a tiny fraction of total gun homicides.

Considering that firearms kill 30,000 people a year, that number makes up an even tinier fraction of overall gun deaths. Obama's proposals to curb gun violence failed years ago because they were overly focused on measures to prevent mass shootings, as opposed to the more common causes of gun deaths. The proposed ban on assault weapons ignored the fact that 75% of gun homicides involve handguns. Additionally, Obama's proposed mental health program, designed to help treat potential killers, did not take into account that those with mental health issues are more likely to be the victims of violent crime, rather than its perpetrators.

This time around, Obama is seeking to require more gun sellers, including those who do business on the internet and at gun shows, to be licensed. This will force them to conduct background checks on buyers; if sellers fail to conduct background checks, they could be fined as much as \$250,000. Obama will hire more federal personnel to conduct these checks around the clock, direct officials to conduct more gun research, better track lost guns, devote an additional \$500 million to mental health treatment, and encourage development of "safe gun" technology.

Many Americans question whether the President's use of the executive order is constitutional - and if his reforms oppose the second amendment. That's not an infringement of their right to keep and bear arms; there's no limit on how many guns they can own. Instead, it's a regulation of their freedom to conduct business - the same regulation that gun stores already endure. As far as constitutionality, the constitution would be purposeless without living, breathing Americans to live under it.

In order to actually affect the murder rate by firearms in the US, gun control legislation needs to be paired with criminal justice reform as well as mental health reform, as Obama has begun to implement. It also needs to recognize the actual root causes of violence entrenched in American culture - race and poverty being top-priority - in order to effectively combat the gun epidemic.

# Special Report: Water Crisis in Hoosick Falls

In 2015, an unsettling discovery was made; one that would change the lives of Hoosick Falls residents as well as HFCS students for a very long time. PFOA, perfluorooctanoic acid, a pollutant known to raise health effects was found in the water supply of our small town, well above the safe limits for consumption. So yes, as news reporters often joked regarding the success of our sports teams, "There is something in the water in Hoosick Falls, New York." This study was found by Michael Hickey, a local resident and current hometown hero, who had a hunch that something was wrong, and went out to find some answers. After the EPA advised residents not to use this tap water for eating, drinking, cooking, and even to be used sparsely when showering and washing dishes, one could definitely say that things seemed bleak and scary. That is, until the people took a stand. Among these people were students of our school who held a student press conference on Friday, February 12, 2016 for the 7th through 12th grade students, teachers, staff, and local press, in the hopes of making a difference. These students exceeded that expectation.

## What is PFOA

- Perfluorooctanoic Acid
- Man-made chemical
- Found in Teflon-coated products
  - Nonstick cookware
  - Microwavable popcorn bags
  - Stain-resistant carpeting
  - Other mechanical and industrial products

## Health Risks

- The Environmental Protection Agency declared PFOA as an "emerging contaminant"
- NYS DEC listed PFOA as a hazardous contaminant
- "Possibly carcinogenic in humans."  
*International Agency for Research on Cancer(IARC) a part of the World Health Organization*
- Linked to certain types of cancers
- Bioaccumulates in human body
- Lack of studies make information more elusive

## Contamination Spread

- Roughly 3,500 are on the contaminated village water system
- Village's most productive well is 400 yards from the St. Gobain plant [which found levels of PFOA as high as 18,000 ppt compared to the EPA's recommendation of safety for consumption at 100 ppt]

## What does Superfund designation mean for Hoosick Falls?

- There will be a long-term remediation of the environment to ensure the safety of residents
- The DEC & EPA remediation plan is separate from the water feasibility study, which has not commenced yet

## What we know

- PFOA has been designated as a possible carcinogenic substance
- PFOA is in the municipal drinking water
- PFOA is currently not in the HFCS water supply
- The long-term health effects of PFOA in humans are still being studied
- The contamination spread of PFOA is being studied by the DEC and EPA to establish a plan for remediation



## Outcomes of Student-Driven Leadership of the Hoosick Falls Water Crisis

-Village, county, state, and federal government not acting quickly enough  
- Governor Cuomo

- Promised "immediate aggressive actions."
- Banned fracking, of which we are greatly appreciative.
- Promised to be a student lobbyist:
  - New water source needs to be funded in this budget cycle.  
Funding for new water source is available if companies don't pay.
  - Hoosick Falls Central School District needs to be connected to the new water source.
- Governor Cuomo committed to installing system treatment at the school and DEC will install in the next few weeks.

**"Governor, as our lobbyist, keep your promise," says Anna Wysocki, spokesperson of the conference.**

**And guess what? He did keep it!**

Merely a few hours after the conference had concluded, Governor Cuomo discharged a press release, indicating that the state would allocate \$10 million to not only assisting in the search to find a new water source, but also for installing in-home filtration systems for all the residents of the village.

Never doubt that a small group of thoughtful, committed citizens can change the world. Indeed, it's the only thing that ever has.




