
Headmaster's Greeting



Claudia — Take care of yourself. I'll miss you.





Hoosac Lifeguards

New Core of Highly Trained Students & Faculty

With the realization that New York State requires certified American Red Cross Lifeguards to be protecting our pool whenever it is open, Donn Wright went through rigorous training by the Red Cross, becoming a lifeguard instructor, a certification he obtained a few years before when he was a boarding school student. Also, history master Jason Wright acquired qualifications as a Red Cross Lifeguard, and so did Athletic Director, Michael Ryan.

To qualify to take the course, a candidate must be a strong swimmer and pass a lengthy and rigorous swimming test. The course is presented in a 300-page textbook and on video tapes. It calls for twenty-eight hours of training and at Hoosac it's done in eight separate sessions. There is a written forty-question examination in which each candidate must receive eighty percent or better. Candidates must pass a course in CPR for the Professional Rescuer and in First Aid before qualifying as a lifeguard.



Henry Bloomquist Honored



On October 7, a banquet was held to honor Henry Bloomquist. It was not his birthday, and he was not retiring, it just seemed after all these years at Hoosac we ought to do something special for Henry! In the fall of 1966 Henry retired from his job as a pattern maker at Noble & Wood Company and came to Hoosac. He's been here since, so he is our

longest tenured employee.

A pattern maker is the most sophisticated level for anyone who works with wood. Henry made wooden patterns to be cast as steel molds for machinery parts, therefore, his accuracy had to be within thousands of an inch.

Henry learned his trade as a pattern maker in 1917 at the Walter A. Wood Company in Hoosick Falls.

Many of Henry's friends from town were invited and Hoosac maintenance people who have worked with Henry such as George Spindell and Wally Davenport.

He likes to wear sweaters and was presented with a navy blue sweater from L. L. Bean with the Hoosac School crest on it. He was also presented with a framed certificate making note of his long, loyal service. He enjoyed seeing many friends and colleagues and he enjoyed the dinner. He addressed the student body afterwards, counseling them to work hard and get the best education they can. Henry now works three days a week, half a day each time. He repairs broken furniture and all sorts of things that need repair and attention. He is now 94 years of age.

Students of the Week




