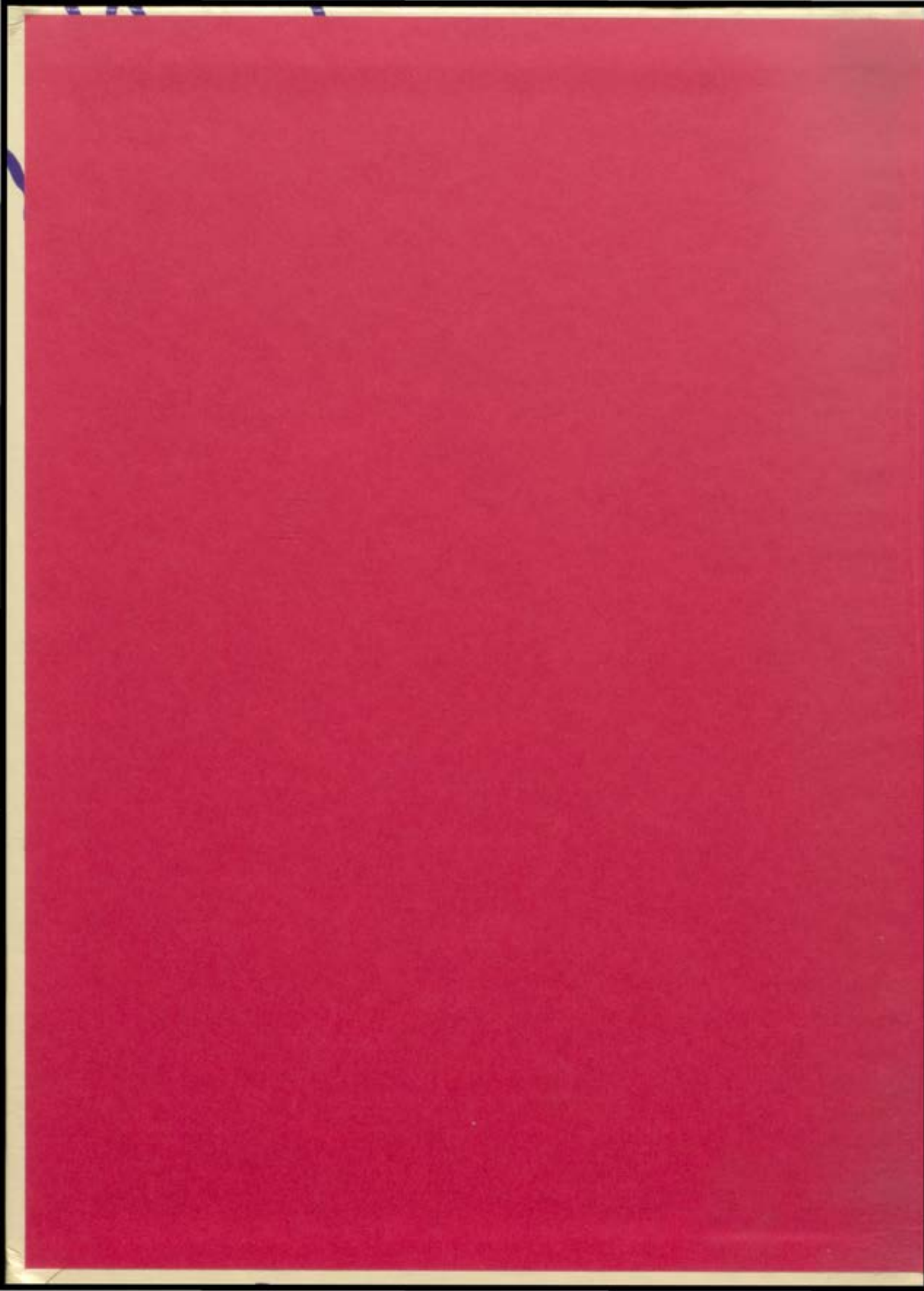
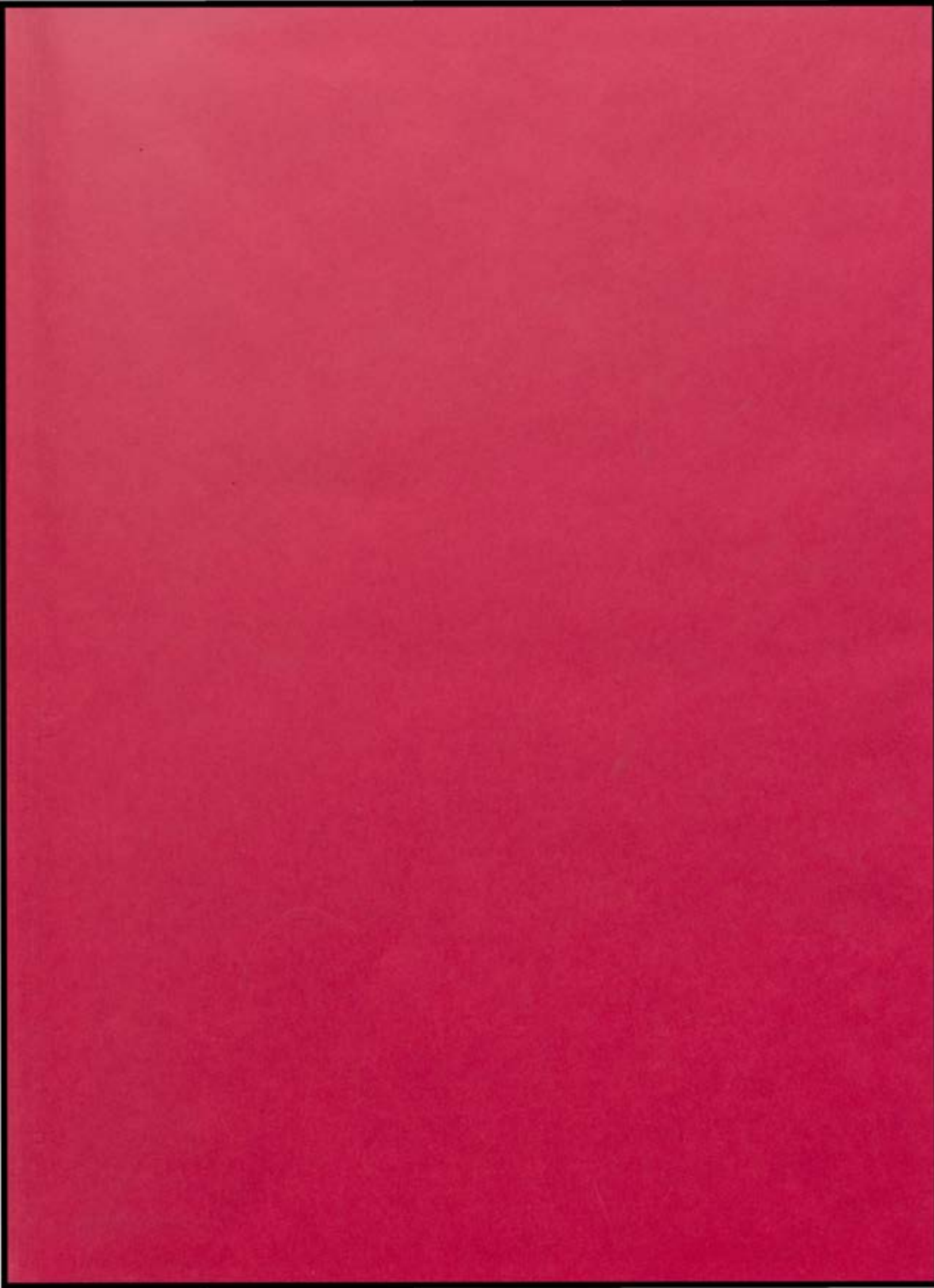

To the Class of 1999,

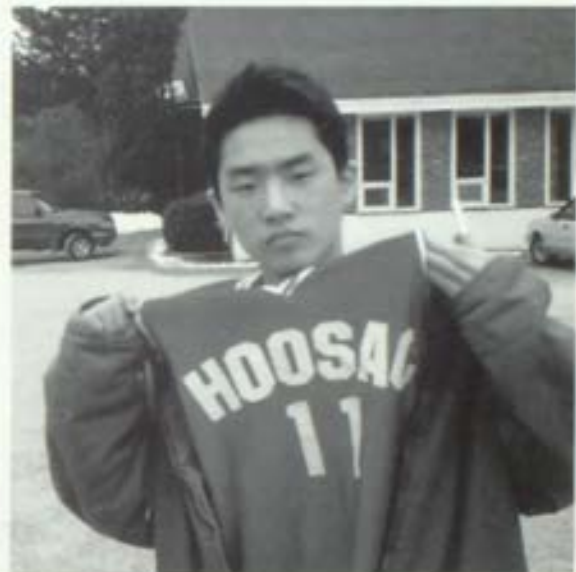

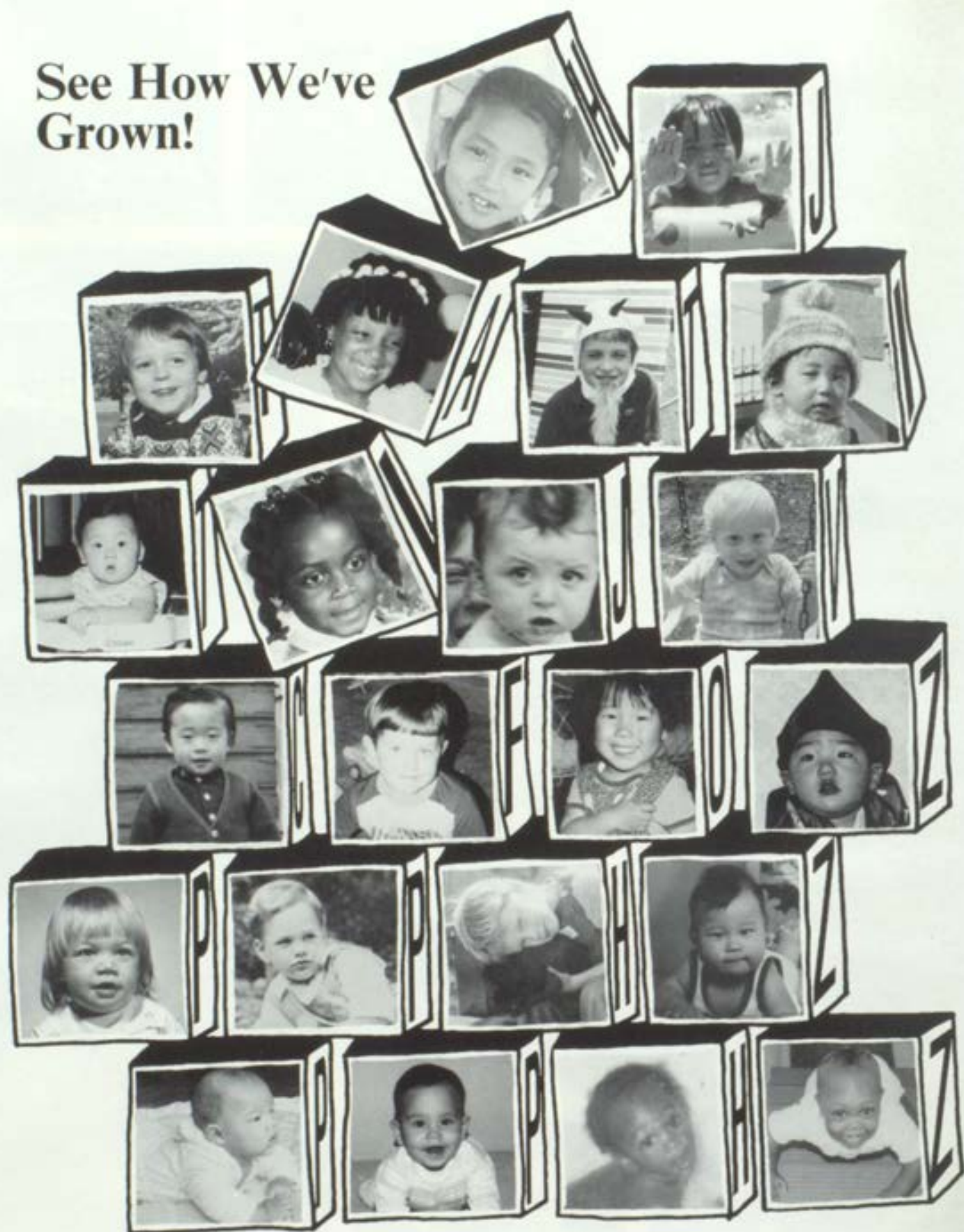

Suzanne: So we got into a lot of fights but you still were able to be by my side, thanks. Raise the roof. Keep it safe, and have fun in your senior year.

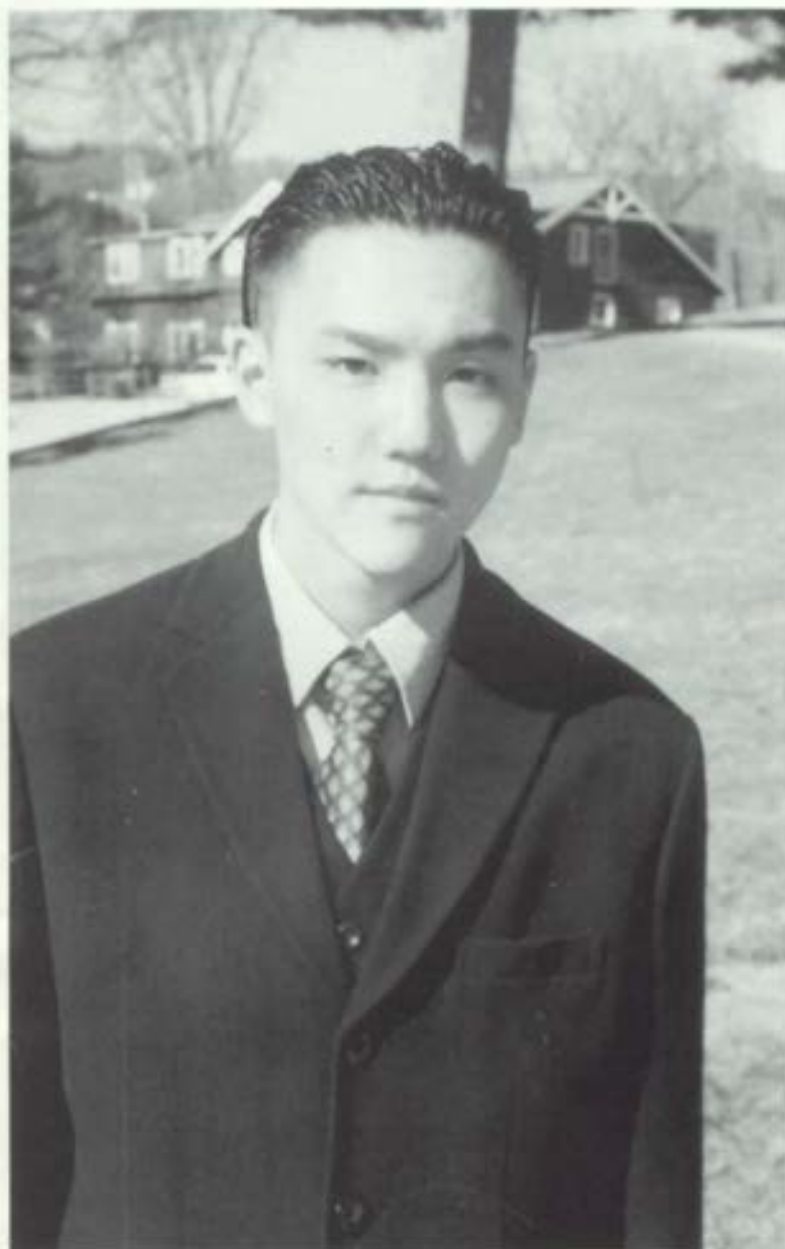


To all the people that I have missed. I didn't forget you. I will always remember you. You are all special people. Just remember that your business is your business. Keep it safe.
