stopped speaking one sentence earlier," or "He's one brick short of a load," are just two examples.



In Memorium:

Francis Whitcomb, 1923-2017

Mr. Francis Whitcomb was Hoosac's oldest living alum until his death this summer. We remember him in the 2017 Owl for his lifelong dedication to, and influence on, the Hoosac community.

"Hoosac was my home for 11 years, from 1930 to 1941. [It is] a very special place," he had told Nurse Klein. He graduated from Hoosac in 1941, but that milestone didn't prevent him from preserving the traditions of the school throughout his life. He pursued a career in the most precious of Hoosac's practices, education. Mr. Whitcomb earned a Bachelors degree from Bard College, then a Master's in Education from The Putney Graduate School.

After serving in World War II, Mr. Whitcomb established his career as a teacher at various day schools, including the Hickory Ridge School, the North Country School, and the New Canaan Country Day School. From 1966 until the fall of 1973, Fran served as a teacher, after which he became headmaster of the Putney Grammar School. Through the power of education, Mr. Whitcomb influenced many young minds, just like the teachers at the Hoosac School had done for him.






