In 1865 he was replaced by Father E. A. Dalley who served the parish until 1874. Today's parishioners can be grateful to Father Dailey whose faith and foresight were responsible for the building of the pretent church. At the present time the parish is headed by the Very Reverend Charles E. Bauman, O.S. A., pastor. His assistants are Father Lawrence J. Gerrity, O.S. A. , Father Thomas R. Cook, O. S. A., and Father Alfred Ellis, O.S. A.
