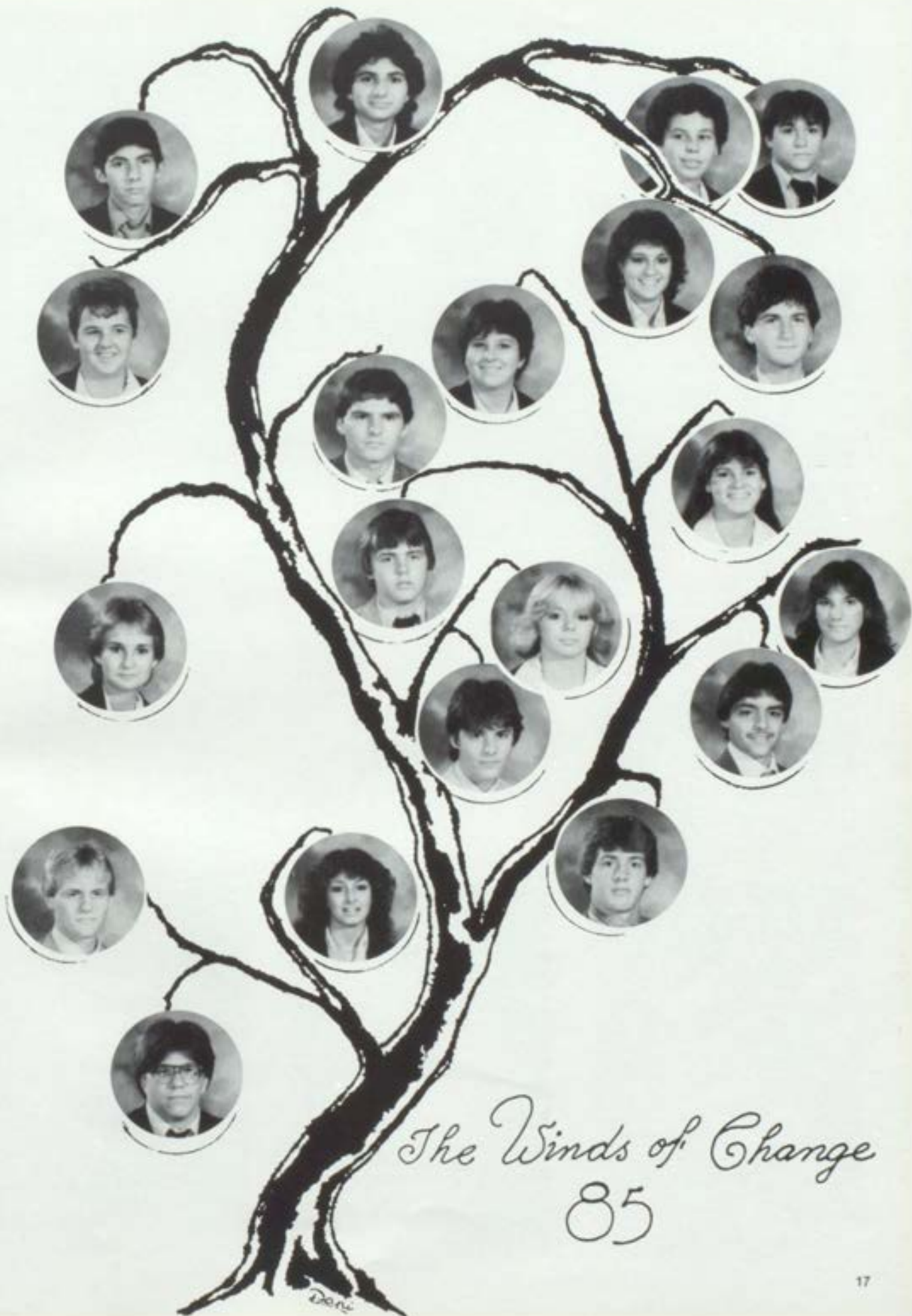
Change is an accepted part of life. Growth, ideas, moves to new locations, new friends, jobs and occupations — these are all things that create a stimulating life of opportunities.
