Why We Exist

Core Promises

1. Empowering Gambians & Ending Poverty

4. World-Class Infrastructure & Energy Independence

- Build and modernize roads, ports, airports, and bridges to connect communities and attract investment.
- Ensure 24/7 electricity by investing in solar, wind, and hydro power, aiming for energy independence by 2035.
- Expand clean water and sanitation to every village and town.
- Launch a Digital Gambia Program to connect schools, hospitals, and businesses with affordable internet.

5. Quality Education for All

- Provide free and compulsory basic education for every Gambian child.
- Reform school curricula to emphasize STEM, entrepreneurship, and digital literacy.
- Offer scholarships and student loans so no Gambian is denied higher education because of poverty.
- Upgrade schools with libraries, labs, and internet access.

- Strengthen partnerships with ECOWAS, AU, and global investors to position The Gambia as a world-class hub for trade, tourism, and peace.
