

Dealer ordering frames, must include a copy of his Federal license with his order. NO DISCOUNT TO DEALERS. NOTHING SOLD ON OPEN ACCOUNT NOR DO WE SHIP C.O.D. All parts except those marked NEW, come from original, genuine Luger pistols. It is to be expected that parts will show some degree of wear, but we discard all parts that show EXCESSIVE wear. Unlike other dealers, we DO NOT get our parts from "junker" pistols. All parts come from Lugers in NRA Good or better condition. PLEASE, use the name and part number when ordering. This saves us from possibly shippin the wrong part. PLEASE FRINT YOUR NAME AND ADDRESS SO WE WON'T SHIP TO THE WRONG PLACE OR PERSON. - *I-3. We must charge extra for barrel extensions only, since we must pay a local gunsmith to remove the barrels. He is the only gunsmith in Michigan who has the proper tools and dies to remove barrels without damaging the extensions.
- *I-IO Entire toggle assemblies do NOT include extractor, firing pin and spring.
 *I-16 Sideplates may be reblued and may have minor blue wear or surface scaling.
- *I_22A These extruded steel magazines were made by Haenel_Schmeisser and bear the German war code designations such as FXO, 122, etc. They will outwear 2 or 3 stamped metal variety. Some have aluminum end pieces, so black plastic.
- *I-22B These bright metal magazines are the first of the extruded steel magazines made by Haenel-Schmeisser and bear the name "Haenel-Schmeisser" on them. A definite collectors piece, they were originally designed for the Krieghoff commercial Luger and are identical to the military "FXO" in construction.
- "L-37. These cleaning rods were made for the 4" and 6" barrelled Luger and have a container at the top made to hold a vaseline like substance to lubricate the Luger. The cap of the container has a small "spade" to spread the oil.
- "I-38. These are military holsters and each has a pocket for an extra magazine, plus a small pocket under the flap to hold the stripping tool. Originals.

I REPEAT, IT IS LEGAL TO ORDER AND RECEIVE FIREARM PARTS EXCEPT THE FRAME, WHICH MUST GO TO A FEDERAL LICENSED DEALER. SO PLEASE FEEL FREE TO ORDER.
