1. DWM 1908 NAVAL, 9mm 6" barrel, 100-200 meter rear sight. 97% bright original blue, 50% straw. Exc. bore, Exc. dark walnut grips. Proper Naval proofs in all the right places. Magazine is non-matching but Naval proofed, without concentric rings. This is a very desirable and scarce variation in really fine condition. \$550.00
2. SIMSON REWORK of ERFURT, with COMPLETE AND WORKING MAGAZINE SAFETY. This piece was originally a 1908 Erfurt but it has had a sear safety, magazine safety and a Simson barrel added. The receiver is dated 1917. All numbers match except for the Simson proofed barrel which is un-numbered but is size marked (8.82) and has a large eagle and a P overstamped on a T on the right side, and the rear toggle pin. 50% original blue, 40% straw, good grips, missing holdopen. Made without stock lug. \$135.00
3. 1902 LUGER CARDINE, No collection is complete without this most desirable variation. 7.65mm 11 3/4" barrel. 95% original blue with a few freckles. 70% original straw. Bore VG. Nice original grips and forend wood, just a few minor nicks. Overall excellent. \$1,150.00
4. 1917 DWM ARTILLERY, 8" 9mm barrel. 98% original blue and straw. No wear except a minute amount at muzzle and sharp edges of sideplate hump. Excellent grips and bore. Fine tuning front and rear sights. A real beauty. \$295.00
5. 1921 DWM LUGER, 4" 9mm barrel, exc. bore, exc. walnut grips, 95% plus blue, 85% straw. This piece has a five digit serial in the 87000 range. It also has a sear safety and frame is drilled for magazine safety but frame strip is not cut for the other end of the spring. The sideplate is numbered in both the military and the commercial fashion. The barrel has PT and eagle proofs, the receiver has WAA eagle proofs. Five digit serial on barrel, frame and receiver. A very unusual piece. \$200.00
6. byf 41, 4" 9mm barrel. 99% original brilliant Mauser blue. Mint bore. A small nick (1/32") at the top of the sideplate. Black plastic grips. Buy this black beauty and you'll never need to upgrade. \$105.00
