1. 1902 LUGER CARBINE. No collection is complete without this most desirable variation. 7.65mm 11 3/4" barrel. 95% original blue with a few freckles. 70% original straw. Bore VG. Nice original grips and forend wood, just a few minor nicks. Overall excellent. \$1,150.00
2. 1921 DWM LUGER, 4" 9mm barrel, exc. bore, exc. walnut grips, 95% plus blue, 65% straw. This piece has a five digit serial in the 87000 range. It also has a scar safety and frame is drilled for magazine safety but frame strip is not cut for the other end of the spring. The sideplate is numbered in both the military and the commercial fashion. The barrel has PT and eagle proofs, the receiver has 'AA' eagle proofs. Five digit serial on barrel, frame and receiver. A very unusual piece. WITH TWO MATCHING MAGAZINES. \$200.00
3. 1906 DWM COMMERCIAL 7.65mm, 4 3/4" barrel, all matching except clip. 95% original blue with freckling and sulling particularly on the grip straps. 60% straw. Bore good. This is an early grip safety 1906 made on the LONG FRAME AND RECEIVER. Dark walnut grips are excellent. \$295.00
4. 1908 DWM COMMERCIAL, 9mm 4" barrel, all matching except clip. DUG proofs. 95% original blue but straps are beginning to brown slightly. Blue wear only from holster. Bore good. 40% straw. Made without holdopen. Grips original dark walnut and excellent. \$235.00
5. 1920 DWM COMMERCIAL, 3 3/4" 7.65mm barrel. 97% original blue, 65% straw, bore exc. Characteristic light grips. A very clean specimen. \$135.00
6. 42 CODE 1939, 9mm 4" barrel, 96% original blue. Wear only on edges. Excellent original walnut grips. Bore exc. match except mag. \$160.00
7. 42 CODE 1940, 9mm 4" barrel, 96% original blue is bright and smooth. Bore exc. TWO MATCHING MAGAZINES. It doesn't take many words to describe a gun in such fine condition. This one is good enough for any collection. \$215.00
8. 1914 DWM NAVAL, 6" 9mm barrel. Chamber dated 1917. Proper Naval proofs in all the right places. Matching except magazine. Excellent original walnut grips. 75% original straw. 90% original blue with slight pitting on the sideplate and left rear of the frame only. Exc. bore. Navals are becoming increasingly scarce on today's market. Would rate Exc. plus except for the slight pitting mentioned. \$395.00
9. S/42 G DATE, 9mm 4" barrel. All matching including magazine. Exc. bore. Sharp excellent walnut grips. 97% blue, 95% straw. Just a little dulling on the grip straps. Also has scar-safety. I never saw a G Date with a scar-safety before. A desirable variation in outstanding condition. \$235.00
10. CONSECUTIVE PAIR OF LATE S DATE KRIEHOFFS. Each has 95% original blue. Exc. fine checkered plastic grips. Overall both pieces are exc. Probably the ONLY consecutively numbered Kriehoffs in any collection anywhere. \$1,150.00
11. 1914 DWM COMMERCIAL, This is an example of a little known variation. See pages 122-123 of Kenyon's book. 95% original blue with moderate spotting. 25% straw remains. All matching except clip. Nitro proof lying down on left of receiver, breechblock and forward toggle. Early type scar-bar. Also has British proofs. Bore exc. Walnut grips exc. Rare. \$350.00
