All others will be shipped by REA AIR EXPRESS COLLECT. BE SURE TO INCLUDE CERTIFIED COPY OF FEDERAL LICENSE. THIS IS A MUST.

1. 1923 STOEGER AMERICAN EAGLE. 3 7/8" 7.65mm barrel. 97% original deep blue, 70% straw. Exc. dark walnut grips, mint bore. Has both frame and receiver markings. This very pistol #8750 is pictured and identified on pages 164-165 of Jones book. Configuration of barrel band (which is same as G date) and relieved firing pin indicates manufacture about 1935, which was after the move to Oberndorf. The serial does not have a letter suffix. The Stoeger is the only variation with sufficient markings on the right side to justify displaying it with the right side out. Own it for . . . \$900.00
2. 1911 Military with DWM toggle. This is an arsenal rework of an Erfurt. All parts Erfurt proofed except toggle assembly which also has matching numbers, but is DWM manufacture. 96% blue 90% straw. Bore VG. Scar Safety, Pat Erfurt grips VG plus Holdopen added. PVM 19 on front strap. Overall excellent. One unusual feature is that the firing pin has the FULL 4 DIGIT SERIAL on it. \$120.00
3. S/42 G Date, 9mm 4" barrel. All matching including magazine. Exc. bore. Sharp excellent walnut grips. 97% blue, 95% straw. Just a little dulling on the grip straps. Also has scar-safety, unusual on a G Date. A desirable piece in outstanding condition. \$235.00
4. 1914 DWM NAVAL, 6" 9mm barrel. Chamber dated 1917. Proper Naval proofs in all the right places. Matching except magazine. Excellent original grips. 98% original blue with very light pitting on the sideplate and left rear of the frame only 75% original straw. Exc. bore. Would rate exc. plus except for the slight pitting mentioned. \$395.00
5. 1939 MAUSER BANNER. 4" 9mm barrel. 95% plus blue with a few tiny nicks. Exc. walnut grips, Exc. bore. Mauser Banner on toggle, Oberndorf proofs. Buy this "Original" Mauser for less than the current new model. \$250.00
6. 1933 ? BLANK TOGGLE. 9mm 4" barrel. 97% blue, 70% straw. matching magazine. Excellent walnut grips, mint bore. Scar Safety, magazine safety. Wa166 Eagle on right of receiver. Nitro proof on left. L.H. 77 on front strap 77 on mag. bottom. \$250.00
7. 1900 AMERICAN EAGLE. 4 3/4" 7.65mm barrel. 60% original blue and straw. VG original grips, G-VG bore. Proper magazine. A good bit of blue wear but has never had any rust or pits. Deep sharp Eagle. \$250.00
8. ABERCROMBIE & FITCH. 4 3/4" 7.65mm barrel. 99% plus Swiss type rust re-blue and straw. Deep sharp Swiss Cross on chamber. Abercrombie & Fitch Co. New York and Made in Switzerland inscribed in two lines on top of barrel. Serial on bottom of barrel parallel to axis of the bore. Serial in proper series. Exc. dark walnut grips. You can imagine how few collections have one of these - See Kenyon pages 198-199. \$550.00
